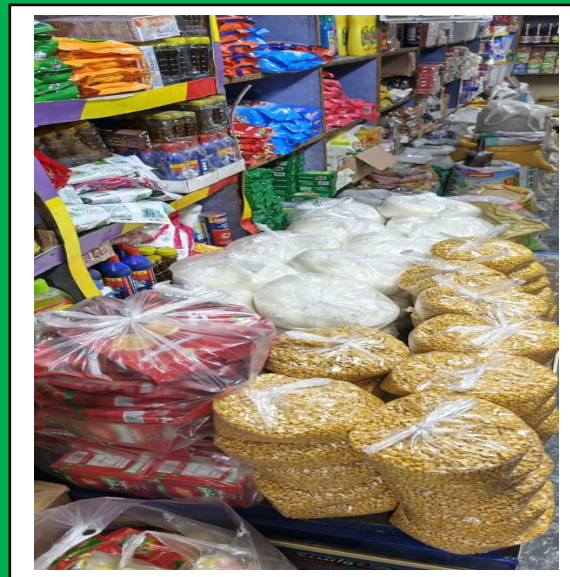


Food Ration Distribution Sialkot August 2025

NHSD - Recent Flood Activities in Sialkot

In August 2025 Sialkot received 405mm of rainfall within 24 hours, breaking the previous record of 339.7mm set in 1976. The recent flood has caused significant damage to lives and property, leaving many without access to basic necessities like food. In response, Network for Human and Social Development (NHSD) launched a free food distribution program to provide relief to affected communities.

Objectives

- Provide essential food items to vulnerable populations affected by the flood.
- Alleviate hunger and malnutrition among affected communities.

Distribution Process Food Items:

The Network for Human and Social Development (NHSD) distributed essential food items, including:

- Grains -wheat flour, rice, etc.
- Cooking oil
- Sugar, Tea



Distribution Method:

Food packets were prepared and distributed to beneficiaries in affected areas.

Target Beneficiaries:

The program targeted vulnerable populations, including low-income families, women, children, and the elderly.

- Logistical Issues:

Challenges in transporting food items to affected areas due to damaged infrastructure.

- Limited Resources:

Insufficient funding and resources constrained the scope and duration of the program.
