Many of these households are led by women who carry the weight of feeding their families, often with little support, little income, and no reliable tools to fight the effects of climate change.

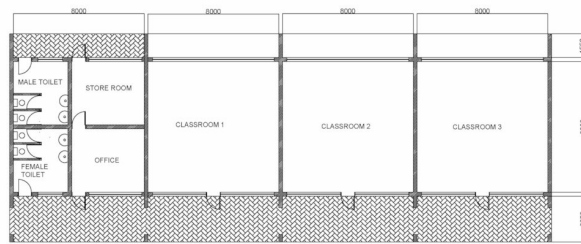


In Seke Rural, water is more precious than gold.
