1. Emergency assistance for displaced persons in North and South Kivu, DRC

With the armed conflicts in the DRC's North and South Kivu provinces, many families find themselves in displaced persons' camps, with many needs, especially for women and children, who remain one of the most marginalized populations. In the DRC, there are around 7 million internally displaced people, and in North and South Kivu alone there are over 1 million displaced people, some of whom live in IDP camps, others in schools, churches and host families. This is why CHWID is trying to provide emergency assistance to certain families.
