Support Flood-Affected People in Puducherry, India

Project Summary (500 characters)

Heavy floods in Puducherry on 21st October 2025 left thousands homeless and without essentials. Prime Trust is providing urgent relief—food, clean water, clothing, and shelter—while supporting home repairs, restoring livelihoods, and ensuring children return to school. The project also builds community resilience through disaster preparedness and awareness programs, helping families rebuild their lives with dignity and hope.

What is the problem?

On **21st October 2025**, unprecedented heavy rainfall caused severe flooding across Puducherry, submerging homes, roads, and farmlands. Thousands of families were displaced overnight, losing their homes, food supplies, and sources of livelihood. Daily wage earners, women, children, and the elderly were the hardest hit, struggling to access safe shelter, clean water, and basic necessities. Schools and small businesses remain closed, leaving children without education and families without income. Immediate support is essential to help communities recover and rebuild.

How will this project solve the problem?

Prime Educational and Social Trust (Prime Trust), a local non-profit with extensive experience in disaster response, is providing urgent relief to affected families. The project includes:

- **Immediate relief:** Distribution of food, drinking water, clothing, and hygiene kits, with special care for women, children, and the elderly.
- **Recovery support:** Home cleaning and repairs, restoration of livelihoods, and children's return to school.
- **Psychosocial support:** Counseling for trauma and community support.
- **Long-term resilience:** Disaster preparedness training, formation of local response teams, and awareness programs on health, hygiene, and environmental safety.

Over **1,000 families** will benefit directly from this intervention, regaining stability and hope.

- Distribution records of relief kits and materials
- Reports on home repairs, livelihood restoration, and school attendance
- Feedback from community members and local leaders to ensure accountability and transparency
