At just four years old, Gregory has begun school at Kilmandafu Primary School, proudly joining his older brother Darius and sister Doreen. Watching him start this journey is a powerful reminder of why this mission matters.

Gregory was born into very difficult circumstances. His elderly father suffers from diabetes and is unable to provide consistently for the family, and at one point they were nearly homeless. Through your generosity, WOW Tanzania built a small, humble shelter to give them safety and stability. When neighbors saw the work being done, they were moved to contribute materials, and what began as a simple shelter is now expanding into what will soon be a proper home.

This family has been tremendously blessed because of you.

A New Chapter for Nance – Off to Boarding School!

We are excited to share wonderful news about Nance as she begins a new chapter in her educational journey. This term, Nance is officially transitioning to boarding school – a major milestone for her and her family. Until now, she had to walk 45 minutes each way to school – an hour and a half round trip every single day. When we saw her on Sunday, she was limping simply because her legs were hurting from the long daily journey. Boarding school will now give her rest, safety, structured study time, and the ability to focus fully on her education.

Nance's academic performance has been excellent. Her grades are so strong that she has been accepted into a top school, giving her a real opportunity to break the cycle of poverty. This step forward is not just about convenience – it is about protecting her health, strengthening her academic future, and positioning her for long-term success.

At the same time, her mother is in need of support so the children can remain safely in their family environment and out of orphanages or potentially abusive situations.
