The Vimukthi Foundation is a registered non-profit organisation dedicated to uplifting the well-being of underserved communities by providing them with access to free education, nutrition, shelter, and healthcare – the indispensable foundations for building a purposeful life. These include expert counselling and wellness programmes, residential retreats, free medical care, and vocational training. International outreach extends to many countries across the globe including Australia, New Zealand, United Kingdom, Singapore, Dubai and South Korea, conveying the universal message of compassion and peace. A key area of focus is addiction rehabilitation, where the Foundation's holistic approach has helped many overcome dependency and rebuild meaningful lives.

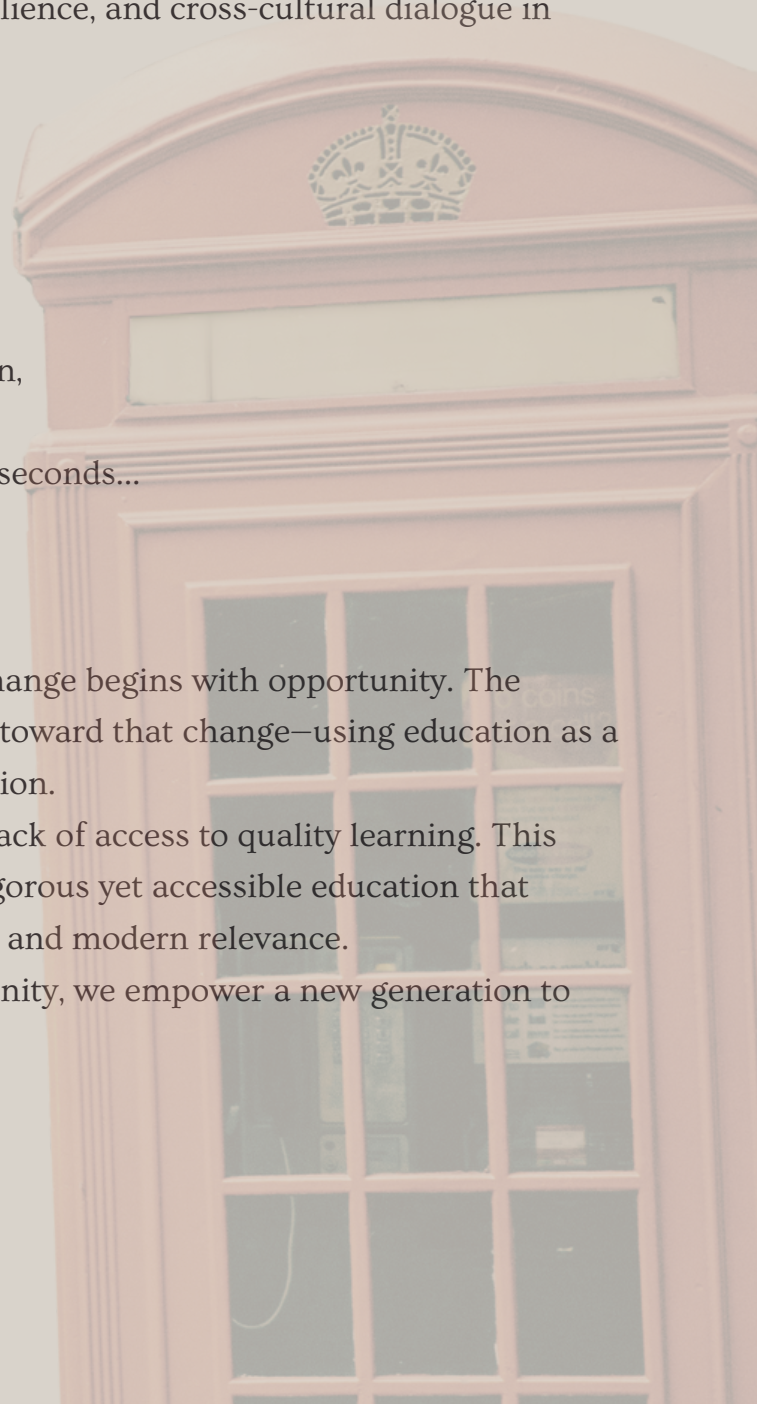

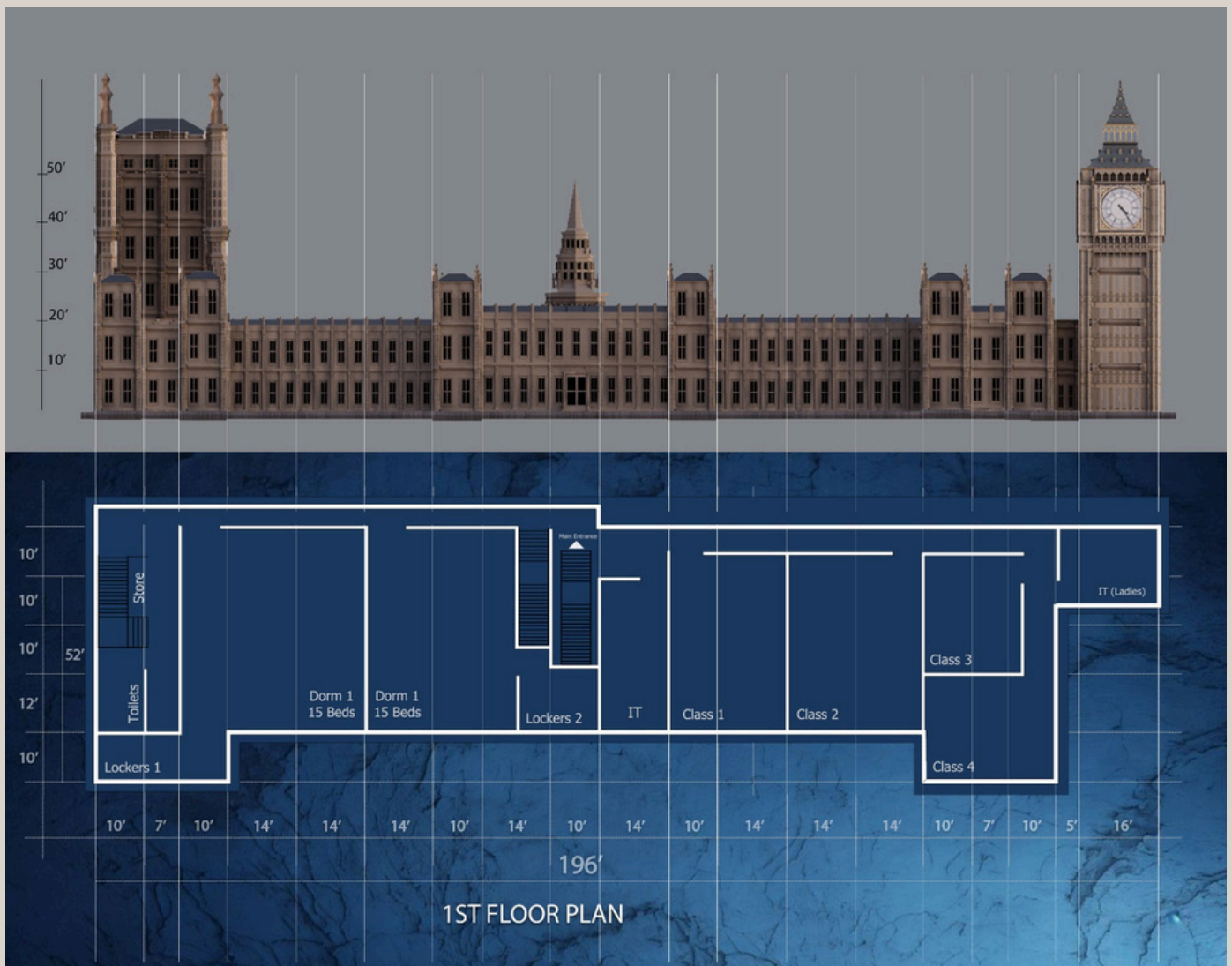

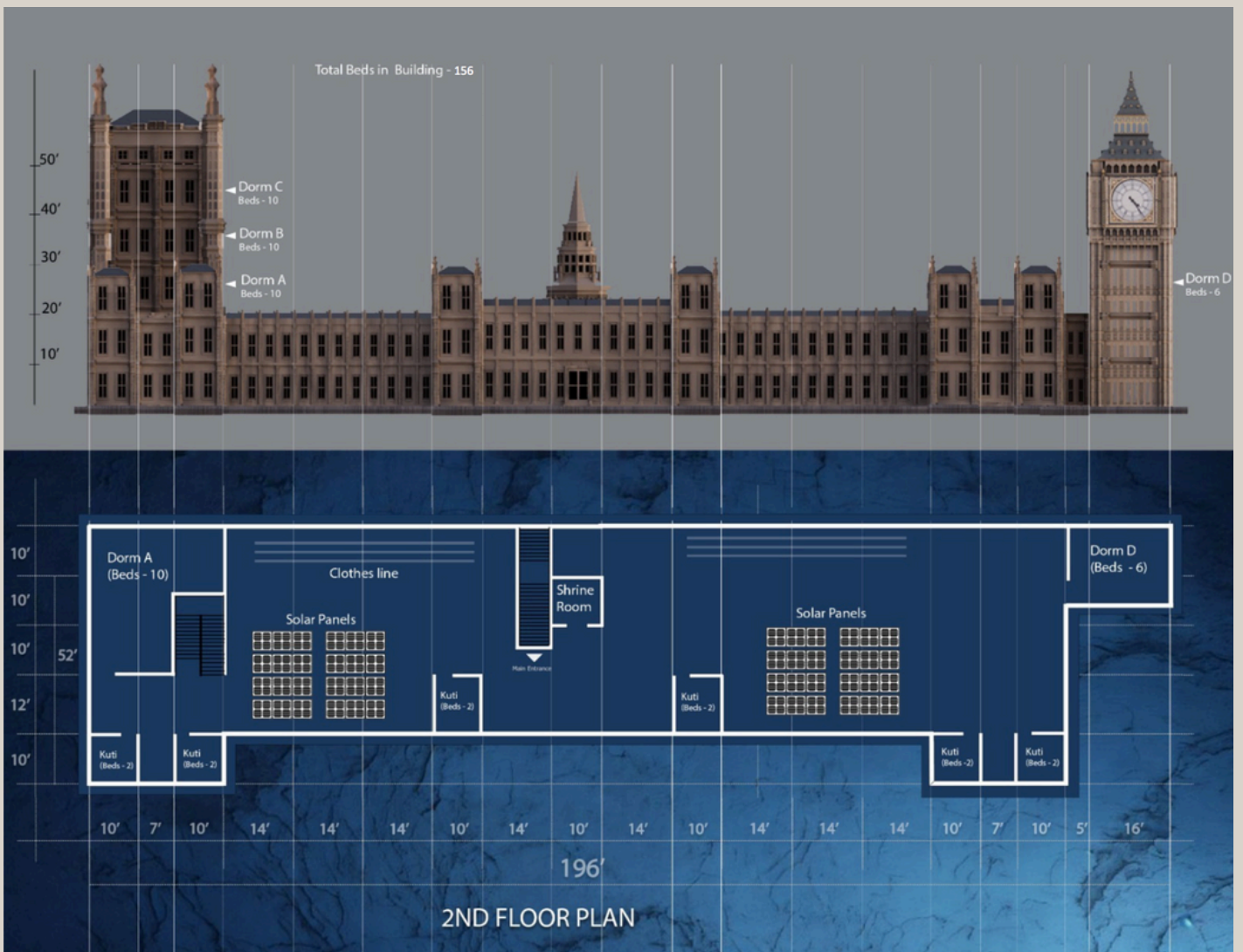
# LAYOUT PLAN - FIRST FLOOR

The first floor is designed to combine residential, educational, and skill-building facilities. It includes two dormitories with space for 30 beds, providing safe and supportive accommodation for students. Classrooms and IT rooms are included to strengthen both academic learning and digital literacy, ensuring young people have access to modern skills. Locker areas, toilets, and a store add to the practical needs of daily life, making the space both functional and comfortable. Together, the first floor complements the ground floor by extending opportunities for learning, living, and personal development in a supportive community environment.



# LAYOUT PLAN - SECOND FLOOR

The second floor is designed to support residential life and spiritual well-being. It features smaller dormitories and kuti rooms that provide additional accommodation in a homely setting. A shrine room at the heart of the floor offers space for reflection and spiritual practice, fostering balance alongside education and daily life. Practical features such as a clothes line and solar panels ensure sustainability and self-sufficiency, reflecting the project's commitment to caring for both people and the environment. Together, the second floor completes the building's vision of creating a nurturing and holistic community space.



## Multipurpose Hall

The multipurpose hall will serve as a vibrant space for learning, collaboration, and community gatherings. With modern seating, stage, and audio-visual facilities, it will host lectures, training sessions, cultural events, and workshops. This space will foster dialogue, exchange of ideas, and shared experiences among students, teachers, and visitors.



## Refelction Garden

An outdoor garden will offer students and visitors a place for rest and reflection. Designed with pathways, seating, and natural greenery, it will provide a peaceful atmosphere for relaxation, quiet study, or meaningful conversations in a calm setting.



## Media Studio

A compact media studio will be created to record lectures, workshops, and group discussions. Equipped with audio-visual technology, it will make learning more engaging and allow educational content to be shared widely online. An adjoining editing space will support the production of quality digital resources, extending the centre's reach beyond its physical walls.

## IT Facility and Counselling Rooms

The IT lab will be a modern hub with computers and tablets for language learning, research, and global connectivity. Students will access e-libraries, dictionaries, and resources in multiple languages to build essential academic and professional skills.

A dedicated counselling facility will offer safe spaces for mentoring, guidance, and virtual therapy, supporting students' emotional well-being and personal growth.

## Library

The library will serve as a centre for knowledge and discovery, offering a wide collection of books on language, culture, history, and global perspectives. Resources in English and other international languages (such as French, Spanish, and Italian) will broaden opportunities for learners. From literature and poetry to modern stories and reference materials, the library will encourage curiosity and independent learning. It will be a calm, welcoming environment where students and visitors alike can immerse themselves in knowledge and reflection.



## Storage Facilities

Practical spaces such as storage and cupboard rooms will ensure a neat and organized environment for students and staff. This simple yet essential facility will support efficient daily living and a cleaner, more focused learning atmosphere.

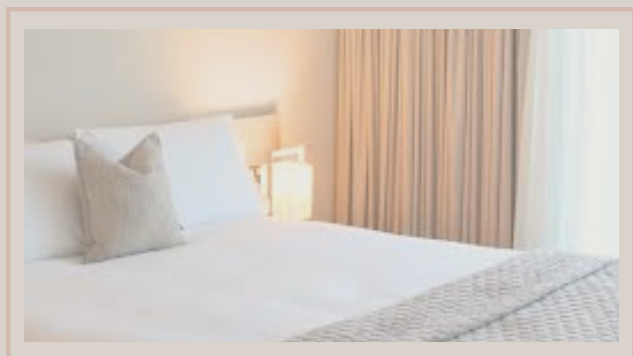
## Classrooms

Purpose-built classrooms will be at the heart of the centre, offering students the opportunity to learn English and a range of other global languages. Equipped with modern teaching aids and digital resources, these spaces will also support lessons in culture, global awareness, and life skills—preparing students to thrive in a connected world.

## Dormitory and Teachers' Rest Areas

Three dedicated dormitories will provide safe and comfortable accommodation for children, teenagers, and adults engaged in the learning programs. Each dormitory will include bunk beds and common areas designed for daily living and peer interaction.

Separate rest areas for male and female teachers will offer a simple, practical space to relax, store belongings, and prepare for classes—ensuring educators have a quiet environment to rest and recharge.



## Health and Wellness Areas

A dedicated sick room and isolation area will ensure proper care for students who fall ill, with safe and hygienic facilities for rest and recovery. These spaces will prioritize health, safety, and comfort, supporting the overall well-being of residents.



## Dining Area

A large communal dining space will allow students and residents to share meals together. This facility will provide a welcoming environment that encourages healthy eating, community spirit, and shared conversation.



## Reflection Room

The proposed reflection room will be a calm and uplifting space designed for quiet thought, study, and personal growth. Simple yet welcoming, it will offer students and visitors an environment to pause, reflect, and recharge. This dedicated space will encourage mindfulness, focus, and inner balance—supporting both learning and well-being.



## Bathrooms and Toilet Complex & Washing and Drying Area

The proposed bathroom and toilet complex is a functional, efficient facility designed to meet the hygiene needs of residents. It features well-maintained restrooms, hand washing areas and a well lit, well ventilated environment. All focused on the core concepts of a simplistic Buddhist life, practicality and minimalism.

The proposed washing and drying area is a practical and convenient space designed to support participants in maintaining the cleanliness of their clothes. Washing stations and drying areas will allow for a quick and efficient job.
