A year with unique challenges

Hurricane Melissa devastated western Jamaica, leaving families without their livelihood, homes, food, water, or safe shelter and exposing them to diseases as well as the elements. Hundreds of students also lost school supplies and have not fully return to their classes. Moved by this crisis, Sabrina an IlluminXation Inc. student from Jamaica, and her Trinidadian peers Amaia and Adiya also from IlluminXation, are leading a youth-driven relief effort to assist 500 hundred families including 1000 students.
