EXECUTIVE OVERVIEW

TOGETHER, WE TRANSFORM COMPASSION INTO CARE.

The Constantine African Foundation (CAF) operates an international humanitarian logistics program that delivers **three (3) full 40-foot medical containers every year** from partner hospitals in **Europe, the USA, and the Middle East** to rural health centers across **Ghana and Ivory Coast**.

Each container carries **gloves, first-aid kits, wheelchairs, diagnostic and dental equipment, hospital beds, and essential medicines**, restoring dignity and access to modern healthcare for more than **10,000 people annually**.

This **\$167,500 annual program** funds the shipment, customs clearance, insurance, and local distribution of **all three containers each year**. Operating transparently under **FDA Ghana** supervision, CAF ensures that the **mandatory 25% import duty** is budgeted and reported quarterly.

Every **\$1** delivers a verified lifesaving item to a rural patient, while every **\$100** funds a complete medical crate that empowers rural doctors and nurses to treat patients safely and locally.

All shipments are **insured end-to-end**, audited quarterly by independent financial reviewers, and published with customs certificates and field photos on **GlobalGiving's Transparency Dashboard**.

Beyond logistics, this initiative builds a **resilient cross-continental health corridor**, proving that when compassion is organized, **hope becomes infrastructure**.

For nurses in rural clinics, it means **clean gloves instead of bare hands**.

FINANCIAL AND TAX TRANSPARENCY

Under Ghana’s regulatory framework, the **Food and Drugs Authority (FDA)** imposes a **25 % import duty** on medical cargo.

All donations directly fund **shipping, customs, and logistics** so that **100 % of donor support becomes tangible medical impact.**

Every \$1 = one verified lifesaving item delivered safely to a patient. This annual budget covers the full **operation of three (3) medical containers**, ensuring continuous delivery and uninterrupted healthcare support throughout the year.

OBJECTIVES

1. **Equip** rural health centers with diagnostic and treatment tools.
2. **Sustain** a tax-compliant medical supply corridor serving remote regions.
3. **Empower** local healthcare workers through continuous resource access.
4. **Ensure** full accountability via FDA oversight and quarterly audits.

Implementation Framework

Phase	Timeline	Milestone
Equipment Collection & Verification	Months 1–2	Partner hospitals donate and inspect equipment.
Container I – Shipping & Delivery	Months 3–4	First 40-ft container dispatched to Port Tema.
Container II – Shipping & Delivery	Months 5–8	Second 40-ft container cleared and distributed.
Container III – Shipping & Delivery	Months 9–12	Third container delivered and impact data compiled.

Monitoring & Evaluation **Continuous** Impact reports issued quarterly to donors.

- Establishes a **sustainable medical supply network** linking continents.
- Provides over **10,000 patients per year** with modern diagnostic and emergency care.
 - Builds **local capacity** and **public-health resilience** through training and equipment.
 - Demonstrates **accountable humanitarian solidarity** from donors worldwide.
