### **1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Under the spiritual oversight of Archbishop Daniel and coordination of Father Irenaeus, this initiative sustains 50 Orthodox mission priests and deacons serving rural communities across Ghana and Côte d'Ivoire.

**This is AN ANNUAL RECURRING PROGRAM REQUIRING USD 65,000 EACH YEAR to ensure uninterrupted support and continuity for all mission leaders.**

Through structured financial support, transport aid, and health insurance, the project ensures no mission leader serves without dignity, safety, or stability.”

Each year, more than 18,000 people benefit through faith-driven education, healthcare awareness, and pastoral care.

Every contribution sustains this continuum of compassion, turning generosity into measurable transformation.

### **2. ORGANIZATIONAL BACKGROUND**

**Constantine African Foundation (CAF)** is a faith-inspired development organization dedicated to empowering mission-based humanitarian work across West Africa.

Partnering with the **Orthodox Archdiocese of Accra**, CF operates under strict financial auditing and transparent donor reporting systems.

The Foundation has built a dual structure of oversight, spiritual supervision by the Church and administrative compliance through independent auditors.

#### **Core Principles:**

- Transparency and measurable accountability.
- Empowerment through faith-based service.
- Sustainability through structured support.
- Compassion rooted in action and dignity.

### **3. PROBLEM STATEMENT**

In rural Ghana and Côte d'Ivoire, Orthodox mission leaders continue to serve families facing hardship, isolation, and limited access to healthcare.

Most walk or travel long distances with scarce resources, balancing ministry with community support.

Without stable financial backing and medical protection, many face fatigue and illness while striving to sustain education, guidance, and social care programs.

When support fades, essential outreach collapses, affecting not only priests, but entire communities that rely on them for hope and structure.

***FATHERS AND DEACONS*** often journeys for hours between villages, ensuring no family is left without care, education, or prayer.

### **4. PROJECT OBJECTIVES**

### **5. IMPLEMENTATION PLAN**

**Phase 1 (Months 1–3):** Allocation of annual stipends, insurance registration, and mobility planning.

**Phase 2 (Months 4–6):** Field supervision under Father Irenaeus; delivery of materials and health coverage.

**Phase 3 (Months 7–9):** Mid-year audit, monitoring of community impact, quarterly donor reporting.

**Phase 4 (Months 10–12):** Impact review, **expansion planning, and renewal under the blessing of Archbishop Daniel.**

## Governance Structure:

- **Spiritual Oversight:** Archbishop Daniel
- **Field Coordination:** Father Irenaeus
- **Administration:** Constantine Foundation HQ
- **Auditing:** Dual system (**internal & external certified auditor**)
- **Transparency:** Quarterly public reports on GlobalGiving portal

## 6. Financial Framework (Annual Budget – USD 65,000)

## 7. SUSTAINABILITY & MONITORING

The project operates under a **Three-Tier Sustainability Model:**

- 1 **Mission Stability Fund (MSF):** Maintains operational continuity during low-donation periods.
- 2 **Monthly Donor Network:** Converts one-time donors into long-term partners for stability.
- 3 **Health Protection Program:** Collective insurance plan covering all clergy and families.

## **MONITORING & EVALUATION (M&E):**

- Field data collection via mission coordinators.
- Quarterly impact dashboards shared with donors.
- Annual audit summary published for transparency.

## **8. LONG-TERM IMPACT AND VISION**

By 2029, the program aims to sustain continuous annual support for 50 mission priests and deacons, expanding to serve over 18,000 individuals yearly across Ghana and Côte d'Ivoire.

Each supported mission evolves into a **community hub of care, education, and hope**, led by local priests and youth mentors.

Through consistent structure and transparent management, this model transforms faith into a living force of social stability.
