## **1 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

In the outskirts of Accra, hundreds of skilled **ORTHODOX YOUTH** live suspended between potential and poverty.

They hold strong vocational abilities, carpentry, tailoring, mechanics, and crafts, yet lack access to capital, mentorship, and markets.

The **CONSTANTINE AFRICAN FOUNDATION'S Faith-Linked Microfinance Initiative** bridges this gap through microloans (\$1,200–\$2,000), business training, and a 12-month guided mentorship program under the Orthodox Archdiocese of Accra. **Each loan becomes a seed for a family business**, transforming FAITH AND SKILL INTO ENTERPRISE, DIGNITY, AND STABILITY.

**Annual funding goal:** \$120,000 ensures all activities remain active and self-sustaining year-round.

**Target 2025:** Empower **80 ORTHODOX YOUTH**, create **120 NEW JOBS**, and establish **8** parish-based enterprise circles within **50** up to 250km of Accra.

## **2 ORGANIZATIONAL BACKGROUND**

The **Constantine African Foundation (CAF)** is a registered humanitarian organization combining faith-driven compassion with economic empowerment.

Since 2015, CAF has successfully implemented over 14 community projects in Ghana and Côte d'Ivoire, supporting education, healthcare, and sustainable mission work under Orthodox oversight.

CAF's governance framework ensures institutional transparency through:

- Dual auditing (**internal + external independent review**)
- Quarterly reporting via the Global Giving Transparency Portal
- Publication of an annual audited report on CONSTANTINE FOUNDATION official platform
- Ethical Code: *"Service, Accountability, Dignity."*

**Recognized by local parishes and aligned with national youth development priorities, CAF functions as a bridge between faith and development.**

### 3 PROBLEM STATEMENT

In Greater Accra, over 60% of Orthodox youth remain underemployed despite possessing viable trade and vocational skills.

Access to small loans or structured mentorship is nearly nonexistent, leading to dependency and social stagnation.

Families lose income potential, parishes lose future leaders, and communities lose innovation. **YET**, with guided financial inclusion, these youth can turn faith and skill into engines of renewal, creating jobs, strengthening families, and restoring dignity across their parishes.

### 4 PROJECT OBJECTIVES

Phase 4 – Evaluation & Reintegration	Q4 2025	Loan recovery, reinvestment, impact assessment, donor reporting

- Each cycle reinforces the next, creating a continuous chain of empowerment.

## 6 FINANCIAL FRAMEWORK (ANNUAL BUDGET: USD 120,000)

## 7 GOVERNANCE & OVERSIGHT

- **Spiritual Oversight:** Orthodox Archdiocese of Accra – *Father Irenaeus*
- **Administrative Oversight:** CAF Board of Trustees – *G. Constantin*

Every disbursement follows the CAF Audit Trail:

*Approval → Field Verification → Quarterly Report → GlobalGiving Dashboard*

An annual audited report is published publicly, ensuring full transparency for all donors.
