QURAN AND YASSARNA DISTRIBUTION PROJECT TO 15 NEEDY SCHOOLS IN CENTRAL AND EASTERN UGANDA

CONCEPT NOTE

1. Background

According to the Uganda Bureau of Statistics, Muslims make up 14 percent of the country’s population, accounting for about 9.1 million out of forty-five million Ugandans. Learning about Allah is a privilege for those who can access it, yet many Muslims across Uganda are unable to obtain the Holy Quran, Quran teachers, or other essential Islamic learning materials. This lack of access often weakens faith and limits the spiritual and educational growth of children and communities.

Recognizing this challenge, Twahirah Islamic Charity Organisation (TICO) has taken the initiative to bridge the gap by distributing Qurans and Yassarna books to mosques, Quran memorisation centers, schools, and individuals through our religious based initiatives program. Through these efforts, TICO aims to bring closer such to vulnerable Muslims who cannot afford these materials, ensuring that no one is deprived of the opportunity to learn and understand Islam.

2. Project Goal

The project seeks to strengthen Islamic education among needy children in Central and Eastern Uganda by providing **one thousand (1,000) copies of the holy Quran** and **three thousand (3,000) Yassarna books** to **fifteen (15)** under resourced Islamic primary schools.

3. Objectives

- To equip 15 needy schools with adequate Qurans and Yassarna books to support structured Islamic learning.
- To enhance Quran reading, memorization, and understanding among school going needy children.
- To foster strong faith development and spiritual growth among vulnerable Muslim learners.

4. Target beneficiaries

The project will directly benefit over **6,000** children enrolled in **15 needy** Islamic schools across Central and Eastern Uganda. Indirect beneficiaries will include teachers, parents, and wider community members who gain from improved access to Islamic knowledge.

5. Implementation approach

TICO will procure and distribute Qurans and Yassarna books to selected schools in Central and Eastern Uganda, working closely with school administrators, local mosques, and community leaders. The distribution will be complemented with short sensitization sessions encouraging effective use of the materials in daily learning and spiritual practices.

6. Budget

The project will increase access to Qurans and Yassarna among children in needy schools, improve literacy in Quran reading, recitation, and memorization, strengthen Islamic knowledge and values among young learners, and reduce inequality in access to Islamic educational resources within marginalized communities.

This project presents an opportunity to empower vulnerable Muslim children in Central and Eastern Uganda by providing them with the fundamental resources needed for their religious education.
