## Help Gaza's Injured Children Receive Life-Saving Treatment and Rehabilitation

### Project Overview

Gaza's health system has collapsed, leaving thousands of injured children with nowhere to turn for the surgeries, prosthetics, and rehabilitation they need to survive. Kinder Relief is responding by supporting some of the most critically injured children and providing them with specialized medical care, long-term rehabilitation, and continuous case support.

This project presents a group of seven children whose lives have been torn apart by war. Each child needs urgent medical intervention abroad or sustained rehabilitation to regain mobility, speech, stability, and dignity. Through this appeal, donors can directly support their recovery and give them a future that is not defined by trauma and loss.

Your donation funds surgeries, prosthetics, wound care, physiotherapy, neurological treatment, and long-term recovery—all of which are currently unavailable inside Gaza.

### The Children We're Supporting

Each of the following children has survived injuries that would be considered medically catastrophic anywhere else in the world. Their stories represent only a fraction of Gaza's suffering, yet every child still has a chance to heal with the right support.

## Nael, 4 Years Old

A missile strike left Nael with a severe head injury and killed his three-year-old brother. His condition is one of the most complex our medical team has seen. His treatment plan is still being finalized and will require neurological care and long-term rehabilitation.

## Mira, 9 Years Old

Mira lost two siblings. She survived with serious leg injuries, including toe amputations. She struggles with balance, mobility, and pain. Without therapy, she risks lifelong disability.



**Needs:** Rehabilitation, mobility therapy, trauma support.

## Tala, 15 Years Old

Tala was playing in front of her home when an explosion caused a traumatic head injury. Her speech, balance, and memory are affected. She needs specialized surgery and months of rehabilitation.

A strike crushed Seraj's leg, leaving him unable to walk. Once full of energy, he now isolates himself because movement causes pain. He needs surgery and rehabilitation to regain mobility.

# How Your Donation Helps

Your support directly funds:

## 1. Life-saving surgeries

Neurosurgery, orthopedic surgery, head reconstruction, wound closures.

## 2. Prosthetics & mobility aids

Custom prosthetics, fitting, adjustments, and gait training.

## 3. Rehabilitation

Physiotherapy, occupational therapy, neurological rehabilitation, speech therapy.

## 4. Wound care & infection prevention

Dressings, medications, clinical monitoring.

## 5. Long-term case support

Housing, transportation, psychological care, nutritional support, school reintegration when possible.

Each child needs an average of **\$15,000–\$20,000** for one full year of medical and rehabilitation support.
