Shelter - Challenges to intervention

Population-related:

Immigrant population with few linguistic resources;

- Lack of professional experience (reception of pregnant adults)**
- Female single-parent families (work-life balance)**
- Social representations in relation to the role of mother (rejection of the regulation of parental responsibilities)**
- Social representations of the user population (welfare and guarantee of rights and meaningless responsibility)**
- Prolonged foster care due to lack of housing responses, mothers with cognitive difficulties, prolonged emotional fragility, mental illness**

Shelter - Challenges to intervention

- Absence of positive change on the part of families of pregnant women and adolescent mothers
- Work/intervention with families of pregnant women and adolescent mothers
- Refusal of the decision to leave (pregnant adults)
- Pregnancy and recent maternity - period of opportunities and guarantee of social protection rights
- Residential care = social housing opportunity (pregnant adults)

Shelter - Challenges to intervention

Structural – related to community services

- Right and duty of collaboration between the entities involved in the process
- Mismatch between the promotion and protection measures applied and the limitations of the resources and objectives of the CAV – Pregnancy in adolescence
- Lack of knowledge of the objectives of life support centres – reception, by community services – requests for reception
