The Project



The objective of these houses, varying with the age and needs presented by the Mothers, is to welcome and carry out a specific intervention plan for each woman with her children, according to her skills, ambitions and life project.

This plan works to promote personal, social and parental skills, so that in the future they know how to respond to the demands that life presents to them, in a responsible, conscious and thoughtful way, ensuring their well-being and that of their children.

The length of stay varies in each house, being longer in the John Paul II House, but it is always intended that the Mothers leave with autonomy: with housing, employment, Baby in daycare and, whenever possible, a support network, the latter of greater relevance in the case of adolescent Mothers.



The Project

Problem: Homelessness and domestic violence place mothers and children in danger.

Solution: Provide secure housing and psychosocial care, promoting reintegration.

Impact (2024): 48 residents supported; 81% with reintegration plans.

Annual Need: €475,724
