...more than 7.000 migrant women are pregnant, and 46.6% of them have been denied medical care because they do not have documents? (CONAPO, 2023)

...since the start of the new administration in the United States, many mothers seeking asylum have been unable to enter the country and have no resources to survive themselves and their children?


...in shelters, babies and children are not allowed to run, shout, play, or cry because their mothers are scolded and, after the third warning, they have to leave?

Help us ensure that migrant women have access to healthcare services and can become mothers in safe environments!

Women who migrate often **escape violence and poverty** in the hope of building a better life. Many go through this while **pregnant or accompanied by their children**. However, the journey they start is far from safe: they face new episodes of violence, discrimination, lack of access to health services, and xenophobia. Those who come from other countries also experience the barrier of language, cultural differences, as well as the lack of the most basic support systems, such as family and friends.

Fondo Semillas is launching the campaign: **Mothers Who Migrate.**

We need to raise at least **27,000 dollars** to continue funding organizations that provide care and support to pregnant **migrant women and their children**, so that even in such difficult circumstances, migrant mothers can experience motherhood with love and care.

Provides pregnancy and childbirth care to migrant women and accompanies them as they begin their journey into motherhood. Their professional, warm, and loving care has reached people from **more than 70 countries**, as they even have translators for Creole and several other languages, so they can accompany women in their own language.

In 2024, they assisted 3,500 women.



Centro 32
Tijuana, Baja California

Centro 32 provides comprehensive support to mothers and their children who are refugees or **displaced by violence in their places of origin**. In their “**Bebebús**” (Babybus), they offer a **safe space to reconnect with their babies through play and love**. They also provide art therapy workshops, entrepreneurship programs, and psychosocial support. This space also enables them to build a sense of community among themselves.

In 2024, they assisted 600 women.
