I- PROJECT STATUS.



During the current reporting period, the Centro de Promoción y Solidaridad Humana, Inc. (CEPROSH) transparently reports that, although this project remains active, **no donations have been received for its implementation.**

The project aims to strengthen the safety, health, and protection of children and adolescents in Puerto Plata through education, gender-based violence prevention, psychological support, and community participation. It also seeks to empower young people with knowledge on human rights and sexual and reproductive health, while promoting support networks and coordination with local authorities.

Despite the lack of funding, CEPROSH has continued working in line with its community-based and rights-focused approach by carrying out actions such as:

- **Promoting the project and increasing its visibility** to attract potential donors and partners.
- **Strengthening technical planning** to ensure the project is ready for implementation.
- **Engaging with community stakeholders** in preparation for effective execution.
- **Monitoring the needs of the target population**, confirming the continued relevance of the issue.

The conditions that gave rise to this initiative persist. Children and adolescents in Puerto Plata continue to face limited access to reliable information, increasing their vulnerability to early pregnancies, sexually transmitted infections, and unsafe environments. In addition, gender-based violence and the lack of psychological support remain significant challenges.

Although the lack of resources has prevented implementation, the need for and relevance of the project remain unchanged. CEPROSH reaffirms its commitment to continue seeking funding opportunities and partnerships to make this initiative possible.

We appreciate the opportunity to keep this project visible and reiterate our willingness to continue working toward generating a positive impact on children and adolescents in Puerto Plata.
