EDUCATION SUPPORT PROGRAM

Supporting Learning for School Children

Many students in underserved schools face difficulty continuing their education due to lack of learning materials. Limited access to books affects both participation and confidence in the classroom. The foundation organised learning material distribution exercises in selected schools to support pupils with essential educational resources. These interventions encouraged school attendance and enhanced student participation during lessons.

HEALTHCARE SUPPORT PROGRAM

Strengthening Local Healthcare Services

Some local health facilities operate with shortages of essential equipment, affecting the quality and speed of care delivery. The foundation donated medical equipment to a community hospital to improve its capacity to provide treatment and attend to patients effectively. The support enabled healthcare workers to deliver services with greater efficiency and improved patient care conditions.

BENEFICIARY EXPERIENCE

A school pupil expressed appreciation after receiving learning materials, explaining that access to books helped improve understanding during lessons and increased confidence in class participation.

Community members also indicated that access to clean water has reduced the daily burden on households and improved hygiene conditions.

Such feedback demonstrates the importance of small but consistent interventions in community development.
