

Project Budget and Overview

Project Overview

This project provides long-term developmental support for a 9-year-old child with autism living in Tbilisi, Georgia. The child experiences developmental delays and challenges with communication and requires consistent, structured support to continue building essential daily life and learning skills.

The project is designed as a 24-month intervention that combines education, therapy, home-based learning support, and improvements to the living environment. The goal is not medical treatment, but stable access to services and conditions that support communication, learning, and overall well-being.

Support also includes guidance and training for the parent to ensure that progress made through school and therapy can be reinforced at home in a consistent and sustainable way.

Use of Funds

The total project budget will be used to support the following areas:

- Specialized education and school-related fees
- Speech therapy and developmental support services
- Educational and learning materials for home use
- Parent training and guidance to support learning at home
- Basic housing improvements, including a suitable learning space and heating
- Nutrition and essential daily living needs
