Kaus-e-Kazah Welfare Organization: Empowering Communities, Transforming Lives

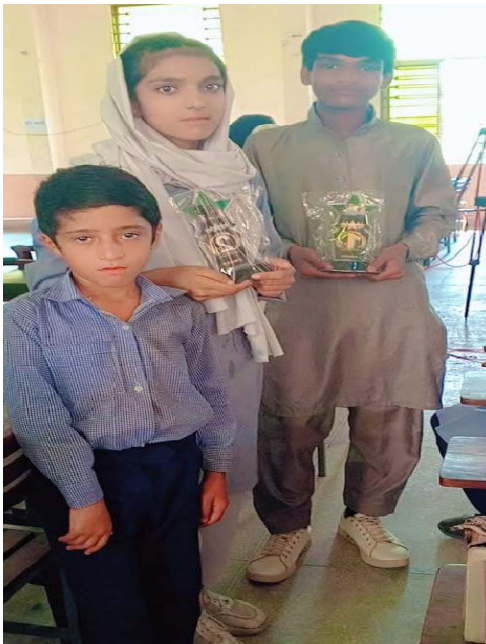

Our Core Areas of Focus

Education & Special Education

At KKO, we believe that every child deserves the right to education, regardless of their circumstances or abilities. Our **Kaus-e-Kazah Special School** provides specialized learning environments tailored to meet the needs of children with disabilities, such as hearing and visual impairments, physical handicaps, and learning delays. Our professional, compassionate staff are dedicated to nurturing each child's potential, fostering a sense of belonging and achievement. By focusing on holistic development, we ensure that these children are not just educated but truly empowered to lead fulfilling lives.



2. Empowering Women Through Vocational Training

We are passionate about uplifting women and girls by equipping them with skills that open pathways to economic independence. Our **Vocational Training Centre**, funded by Pakistan Bait-ul-Maal, offers training in dressmaking, machine embroidery, knitting, and computer skills, benefiting over 50 students each month. With 50 sewing machines, advanced computer labs, and experienced instructors, we give these women the tools they need to start their own businesses and support their families. Our training programs are designed to instill confidence and ignite the entrepreneurial spirit in our participants.



Comprehensive Healthcare & Therapy Services

Health and wellness are at the core of KKO's mission. We offer a wide range of therapy services, including physiotherapy, occupational therapy, psychotherapy, speech therapy, and anxiety counseling. Our healthcare facilities are designed to create a serene, stress-free environment, complete with audio-visual aids and air-conditioned comfort. Each patient receives one-on-one, personalized care from our skilled therapists, ensuring a comprehensive approach to physical and mental well-being.



Our Impactful Projects & Transformative Initiatives

- **Girls' Primary Education in Mehar Village, District Dadu, Sindh:**

In partnership with the Japan Embassy's Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP), KKO constructed and furnished a state-of-the-art school in Mehar Village. The facility now serves as a beacon of hope for 150 families, offering girls the opportunity to receive a quality education in an inspiring environment. By collaborating with the Sindh Education Foundation, we are breaking barriers and creating a future where every girl has a chance to learn and thrive.



- **Non-Formal Education in Maskeenabad:**

Recognizing the urgent need to rescue children from child labor, KKO established a non-formal school in Maskeenabad, Rawalpindi, in collaboration with the Literacy Department. Our school provides free, quality education to 120 children, helping them break free from poverty and discover their potential.



Empowering Women Across Pakistan:

Through our partnership with the National Bank of Pakistan (NBP), KKO has launched numerous projects that have uplifted communities nationwide. Our **NBP Empowered Women, Empowered Pakistan Project** has established 43 vocational centers across Sindh, Balochistan, Punjab, and KPK, offering skills training that empowers women to earn a sustainable income. Each center is a hub of opportunity, where women learn dress design and tailoring and are connected to markets for their goods.



Wheel Chair Distribution:

National Bank of Pakistan are committed to helping the persons with special needs lead a comfortable and better life. In this regard 60 wheel chairs were donated for the physically handicapped persons, 30 in Haripur KPK and 30 in Rawalpindi Punjab.



Healthcare Outreach in FATA:

KKO has organized free medical camps in remote areas of FATA, providing vital healthcare services to underserved populations. Our medical teams offer expert consultations and free medicines, promoting health and wellness in regions that need it most.

Free medical camps are conducted at various places including 2 at Merokas, 2 at Pir Quim, 2 at Jawadara and 2 at Village Masood; Kurram Agency, in which needy people are given free medical advice and medicines by a team of doctors.



KKO and TCF Project:

The Citizen Foundation (TCF) contracted Kaus- e- Kazah Organization in order to establish 10 vocational centers. All these centers have been established. 4 in Khushab, 2 in Manshera, 1 in Muzaffrabad, 1 in Faisalabad, and 1 in Rawalpindi. Initially equipment and furniture were purchased for all centers by KKO, and KKO staff members established centers in already existing school of TCF.

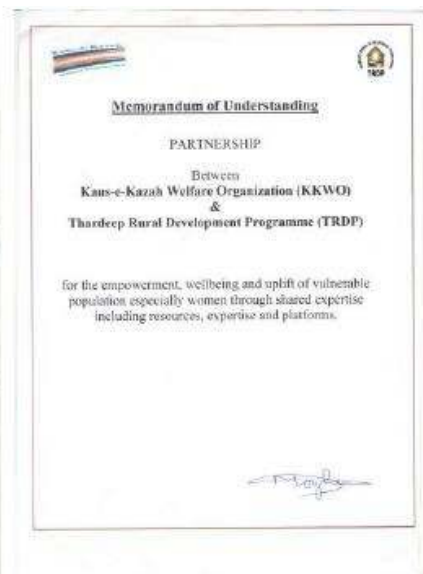
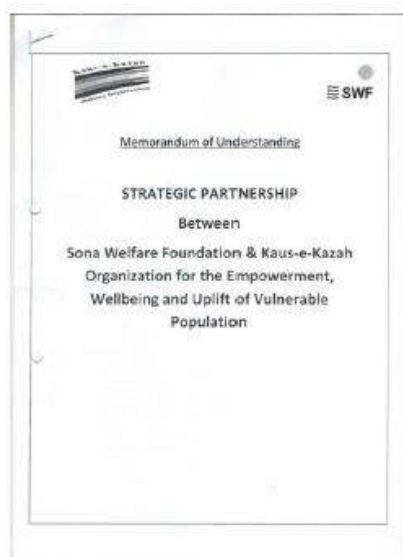
PUNJAB SKILLS DEVELOPMENT FUND (PSDF) PROJECT
