# "ENDING DEATH BY WATER"

A SOLAR-POWERED BOREHOLE & COMMUNITY RESILIENCE PROJECT

Proposed Partnership with Rector Cares Foundation

## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

In Wuro Yayaru, Gombe state, Nigeria and similar rural Nigerian communities, water is not scarce, it is deadly.

Children die not from war or famine, but **from drinking contaminated water** drawn daily from unsafe hand-dug wells. Mothers watch their children weaken from waterborne diseases. Families walk for hours under harsh heat to fetch water that may kill them.

Rector Cares Foundation is seeking **paterners support** to fund and technically strengthen a solar-powered borehole water system, combined with basic social infrastructure rehabilitation and livelihood support, to end preventable deaths caused by unsafe water in this community.

# “The Crisis on the Ground.”

## 1. No Borehole. No Safe Water.

The community has no borehole.

Every household depends entirely on a shallow, contaminated open well. The water is untreated, exposed, and biologically unsafe.

Children are the most affected.



Waterborne illnesses from this well have repeatedly led to severe sickness and death, especially among children under five.

## 2. A Community Without Healthcare

There is no clinic in the community.

When children fall sick from water-related diseases:

1. Families rely on a small pharmacy
2. Serious cases require hours of travel to the nearest health facility
3. Many do not survive the journey

Unsafe water and no healthcare is a lethal combination.



### 3. Education in Decay

The community school reflects the same neglect:

1. Damaged roofing
2. Broken or missing classroom chairs
3. No functional blackboards
4. Learning disrupted during rain and heat

Children are expected to learn in conditions that deny them dignity.



## OUR SOLUTION

### 1. Solar-Powered Borehole Water System

With **YOUR** support, this project will deliver:

- A solar-powered borehole
- High-efficiency pumping technology
- Elevated storage and controlled distribution
- Clean, safe water accessible to the entire community

This will immediately:

- End reliance on the deadly well
- Reduce waterborne diseases
- Save children's lives

### 2. Community Ownership & Sustainability

To ensure long-term operation:

- A trained local caretaker will manage the borehole
- A small water kiosk / corner shop will be established

### 3. Livelihood Support Through Farming

To strengthen sustainability beyond water:

- Community members will receive basic farming support
- Increased agricultural output will:
  - Improve food security
  - Generate income
  - Reduce dependency on external aid

Water access + farming = dignity and resilience.



## OUR SOLUTION

### 4. Education Infrastructure Support

Alongside water access, we will:

- Repair damaged classroom roofing
- Provide desks and chairs
- Restore functional learning spaces

Clean water must go hand-in-hand with education.

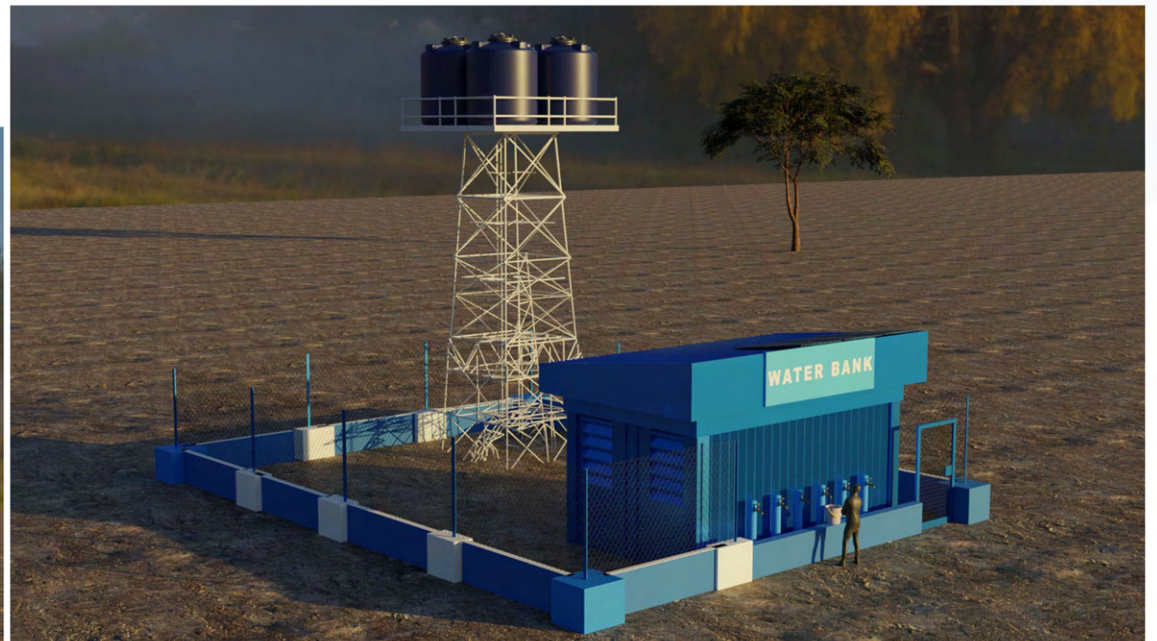
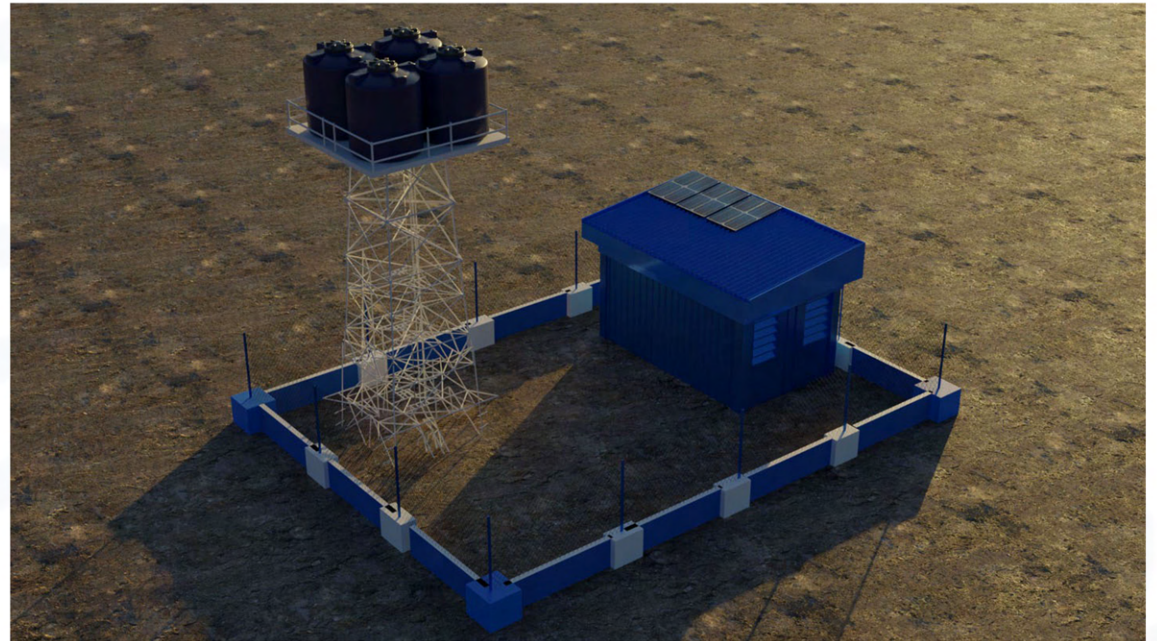
