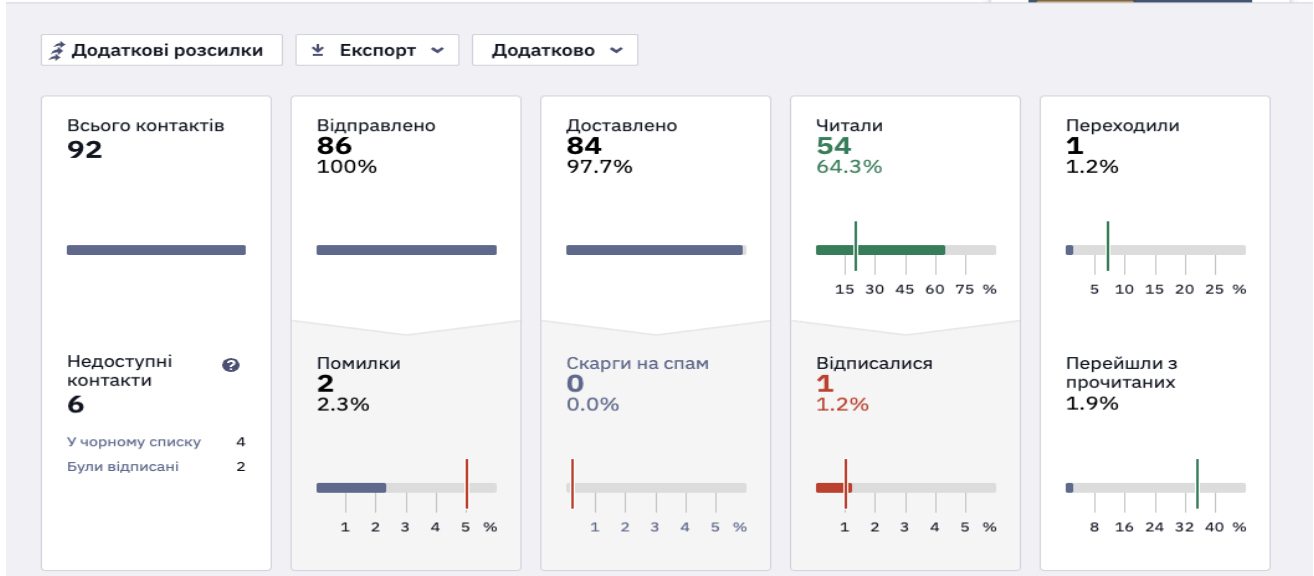

As Ukrainian civil society mobilized to lead both humanitarian and recovery efforts in response to the crisis, demand for strong management and operational skills substantially grew.

Philanthropy in Ukraine helps Ukrainian nonprofits by providing capacity-strengthening programs that support their organizational development and enable them to deliver more effectively.

Global Giving campaign

More than one-third of Ukrainian nonprofits say that existing educational programs for NGOs either lack practical relevance or are not fully aligned with the real needs of their organizations.

In order to address this gap, **Philanthropy in Ukraine uses research and data to identify those needs and develops high-quality learning opportunities** that offer practical tools to help CSOs strengthen their operations and grow strategically.

Comprehensive course "NGO 360"

Covers all key areas of an organization's institutional development — from management and strategy to financial oversight, partnerships, and reporting. Each lecture is led by experienced practitioners. Participants leave not just with knowledge, but with practical tools they can apply immediately.

How 280 Days rebuilt for the long term

a story of returning to the mission

In 2022, many Ukrainian nonprofits suspended their work to avoid conflict with the Russian invasion. The 280 Days Foundation, however, continued its mission — an organization that helps in various ways people who are affected by war. This time, it was not about saving lives, but about helping people to return to their homes and communities. The challenge was figuring out when to begin — and how. The solution? The 280 Days Foundation had a clear and established management strategy in place, and it was just the time to use it and the space for reflection on the journey.

During the months of 2022-2023, the team:

1 defined its vision for the next five years and developed a three-year strategic plan;

2 returned to its mission and vision;

3 adopted a new publishing schedule as a self-sustaining partner in new initiatives.

All of this helped the 280 Days team to continue to support a variety of change-makers across Ukraine and beyond in a long-term sustainability.

How 280 Days rebuilt for the long term

a story of returning to the mission

In 2022, many Ukrainian nonprofits expanded their work to meet urgent humanitarian needs. For **Alesia Azarova**, founder of 280 Days Charitable Foundation — an organization that advances maternal wellbeing in Ukraine by promoting access to essential services — this meant providing humanitarian aid to pregnant women affected by war.

When the initial shock passed, her team recognized it was time to return to their core mission. The challenge was figuring out where to begin — and how. Participation in the **NGO 360° Comprehensive Course on Institutional Development** by Philanthropy in Ukraine gave the team the tools and the space for reflection to find answers.

During four months of NGO 360°, the team:

- 1 defined its vision for the next ten years and developed a three-year strategic plan;
- 2 restructured its staffing model and leadership;
- 3 adopted a new positioning as a civil-society partner to state institutions.

All of this helped the 280 Days Charitable Foundation navigate a period of change and build stronger internal systems for long-term sustainability.
