### SWIMMING ACADEMY

#### IMPACT: 280 CHILDREN.

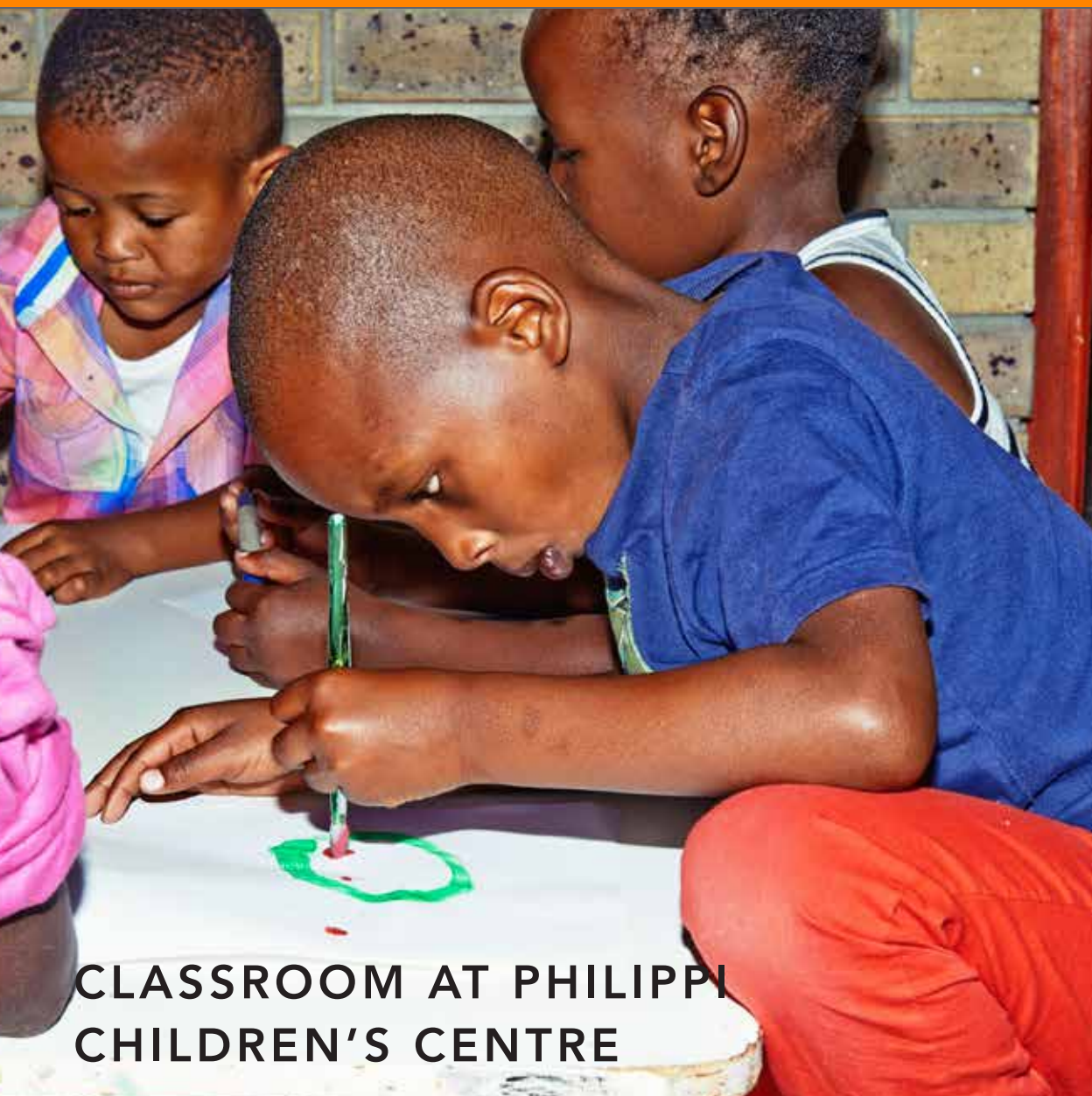
The 280 Children of Phillippi Children's Centre and the surrounding community now have the opportunity to learn the critical life-saving skill of swimming at our environmentally conscious, water-sustainable school. Lessons are \$5 a week – still out of reach for most local families. We currently provide scholarships to 20 children with an active waitlist. Our goal is to make lessons accessible and affordable to all Phillipi youth.



### SPECIAL PROGRAMS

#### IMPACT: 2000 CHILDREN.

Provide support for other Early Childhood Centres, sports equipment, Easter celebrations, transport to camp for the primary schools, special programming, field trips and more.



### CLASSROOM AT PHILIPPI CHILDREN'S CENTRE

#### IMPACT: 210 CHILDREN.

In the seven years since the Love to Langa classroom was built, 210 children have been through the Grade R (Kindergarten) classroom. We continue to fund scholarships there and at Mfuleni Early Childhood Centre.



### HAZEL'S CENTRE OF HOPE ORPHANAGE

#### IMPACT: 8 CHILDREN.

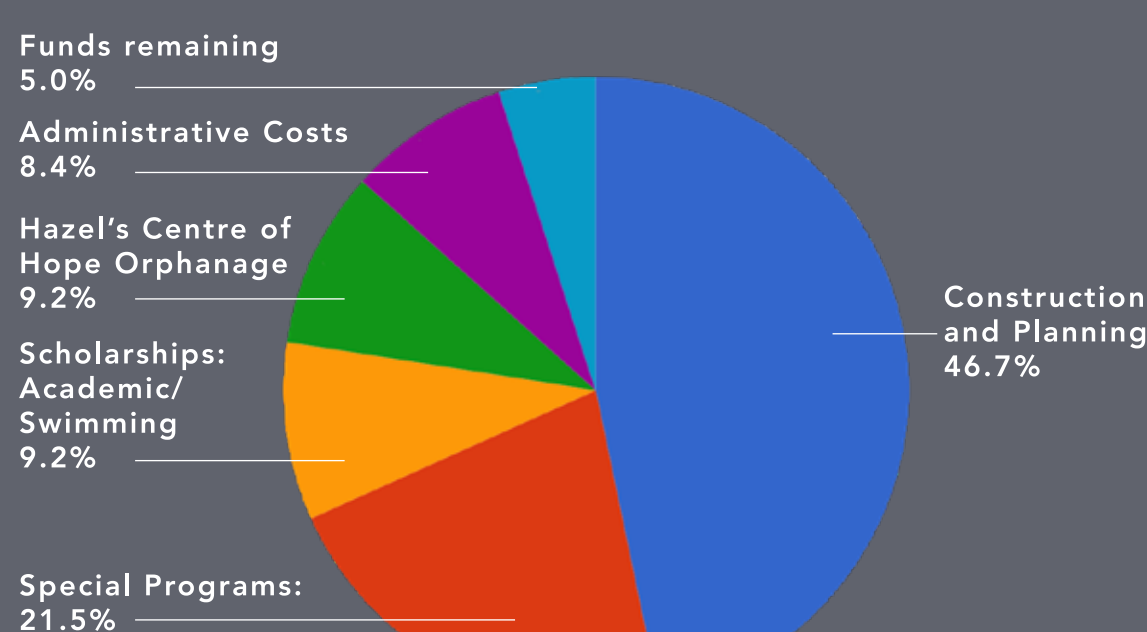
The girls' bedroom had holes in the roof and the electrical wiring was a fire hazard. With the assistance of Global Millennials for Progress, Love to Langa bought a self-contained bedroom unit that is safe and secure. The wiring in Hazel's home was also rewired for additional safety.
