IMPACT: 280 CHILDREN.

The 280 Children of Phillipi Children's Centre and the surrounding community now have the opportunity to learn the critical lifesaving skill of swimming at our environmentally conscious, watersustainable school. Lessons are \$5 a week - still out of reach for most local families. We currently provide scholarships to 20 children with an active waitlist. Our goal is to make lessons accessible and affordable to all Phillipi youth.

The girls' bedroom had holes in the roof and the electrical wiring was a fire hazard. With the assistance of Global Millennials for Progress, Love to Langa bought a self-contained bedroom unit that is safe and secure. The wiring in Hazel's home was also rewired for additional safety.
