World Educare Network - WENET in collaboration with Ubuntu Harmony Initiative established UHI Saloon & Skilling Center in 2024 at Kayunga District, being a grassroot community led social enterprise offering skilled services & trainings.

Aims!

Deliver affordable, inclusive & market-oriented vocational education to the school dropouts, poor women, teenage mothers, vulnerable youth & children; HIV/AIDS victims & survivors, and PWDs within underprivileged communities in Uganda.

What We Offer!

Empowers through practical trainings in Hair Dressing, Tailoring, Garment Cutting & Fashion Design, and Entrepreneurship & Life Skills; Digital Empowerment Programs & other vocations are in plan.

Who Benefits?

Every year, 40 Trainees & Employees at Kayunga, UHI Saloon & Skilling Center, are primary school leavers without further education options and from extremely poor households, vulnerable teenage mothers, school dropouts, persons living with HIV/AIDS & CWDs, victims of GBV & survivors, and unemployed rural youth who can neither afford tuition nor training materials.

Sustainability Assured!

Ensuring sustainability and expanding access, we implement a Training-Production model that integrates learning with income generation. Through partnership-owned enterprise with UHI, semi commercial training units for Hair Dressing, Tailoring & Fashion Design, and planned Computer Skills & Digital Literacy; trainees gain hands-on experience while contributing supervised labor under a work-study system that offsets tuition costs. Income from saloon and tailoring services funds training materials, maintains equipment, subsidizes fees for vulnerable learners, and covers costs of operational while entrepreneurship & life skills practices in making bar soap, reusable sanitary pads, shoes & bags ensures employability, provide affordable products & generate income.

We Are Challenged!

Underequipped yet striving in a rural community facing high unemployment, poverty, school dropouts, early motherhood, limited access to post-primary education, persistent HIV/AIDS and low disability inclusion, we respond to urgent demand for employable skills; restoring dignity, self-reliance & economic opportunity.
