Girls' Education



Education is one of the most powerful tools for social transformation. RSKS India actively promotes girls' education by supporting access to schooling and creating awareness about the importance of education among communities.

Team Structure

As per the RSKS India team, there are 62 members, who are working as full time, part time or as volunteers/interns. Amongst them 28 are females who are working as master trainer, teacher, craft worker, coordinator and administrator.

As per the senior leadership, there are 7 members including 4 women who are associated with the organization since long and performing excellent as per the competitive colleague to each other.

RSKS India always considers the ratio of male female from the governing body to team. This is the best thing of the organization that this is not male or female oriented, it talks about only "Human Oriented".

Board Structure

Governing Board of RSKS India consists of 7 persons elected democratically by its General Body. Elections on the board are held every five years.

RSKS India runs on a fully Decentralized Management System headed by the Chairman & CEO who is supported by a Cadre of Professional & Administrative Staff.

As per the governing body, there are total 7 members including 3 women in which 1 woman is disabled. Apart from that, in Advisory Board there are 5 members, including 3 women. In General Board, there are 14 members amongst them 7 are male and 7 are female. The ratio of all these boards clearly shows that gender inequality does not exist at RSKS India.
