WHO WE ARE

Koampia Phum Yoeung (KPY, or “Our Caring Village” in English) is a non-profit, local community development NGO registered with the Royal Government of Cambodia since 2019. We work in partnership with local authorities, schools, churches, partner NGOs and other development agencies to achieve our vision and mission of addressing the root causes of poverty and family vulnerability.

VISION

We see strong and financially stable families improving their lives and strengthening poor communities across Cambodia.

OUR STRATEGY: MULTIPLICATION!

KPY multiplies its impact by mobilizing and training village volunteers from local schools and community groups through its “training of trainers” (ToT) methodology. These community trainers then teach local families and children how to overcome poverty and become self-sufficient through economic empowerment.

KPY focuses on three areas of need:

Financial Literacy: We promote financial literacy among vulnerable families and children in primary and secondary schools.

Child Rights Promotion and Parenting: We promote child protection, child participation in school and community development, and positive parenting for children and families.

Child Education: We improve children’s quality of learning and life skills development.

WHAT WE DO

Why Financial Literacy?

When vulnerable families and children understand how to manage and save their money, they avoid the trap of borrowing money beyond their means, learn how to plan for the future, and apply practical financial management and budgeting skills. As a result, families report that they no longer live hand-to-mouth, their children stay in school, and do not consider migrating elsewhere to survive.



Why Child Rights Promotion and Parenting?

When children are cared for, protected, and loved, they are able to develop positive relationships with their peers, teachers, parents, and communities. Surrounding children with a healthy, affirming community ensures that they make positive, confident decisions about their own futures. This has also reduced the risk of human trafficking as families become more stable and healthy.



Why Child Education?

Cambodia suffered greatly during the deadly Khmer Rouge regime in the 1970’s. One of the costliest effects was the complete destruction of Cambodia’s educational system. Teachers were murdered and all schools were shut down. As a result, it has taken decades for Cambodia’s education system to be rebuilt. Teachers are poorly trained, and schools have scant resources to ensure a quality education. KPY invests resources in mobilizing school principals and teachers to catch a bigger vision of how they can improve the lives of their students. We provide learning opportunities for teachers, and peer-based leadership exposure and training for school principals. As a result, dozens of schools have raised their standard of education and have created a child-friendly environment for children to stay in school and enjoy learning!
