The Challenge

The EU's Civil Protection and Humanitarian Aid Operations has formally classified Afghanistan among its 2026 "forgotten crises", contexts where crisis-affected populations receive little or no media attention or international aid.

9 million children out of school, 57% are girls

> 90% of 10-year-olds can't read a basic text

> 6 million educated Afghans fled since 2021

Afghanistan is the only country in the world that has banned girls' secondary education. Girls and women are unable to attend school past the primary level, work or participate in public life.



What We Do

Against the backdrop of compounding crises, we develop Afghan leaders who collectively rebuild the nation through high-quality, inclusive, and equitable education.

- 1 We recruit top Afghan university graduates committed to change
- 2 Provide intensive training and preparation
- 3 Place 'Fellows' for 2-years in high-need schools as teachers and leaders
- 4 Build a lifelong network of education leaders driving systemic change



Strategic And Credible

We have maneuvered challenging regime changes strategically for a decade because lasting change in Afghanistan requires legitimacy.

Ministry of Economy – NGO Directorate

- Formally Registered
- Quarterly and annual reporting
- Every project/expansion is government-approved

Ministry of Education

- Annual MoU signed and maintained every year
- Fellow placements processed through the MoE/DoE
- Training materials reviewed by the Ministry
- Random classroom audits conducted
- Physical reports submitted every six months

Ministry of Finance

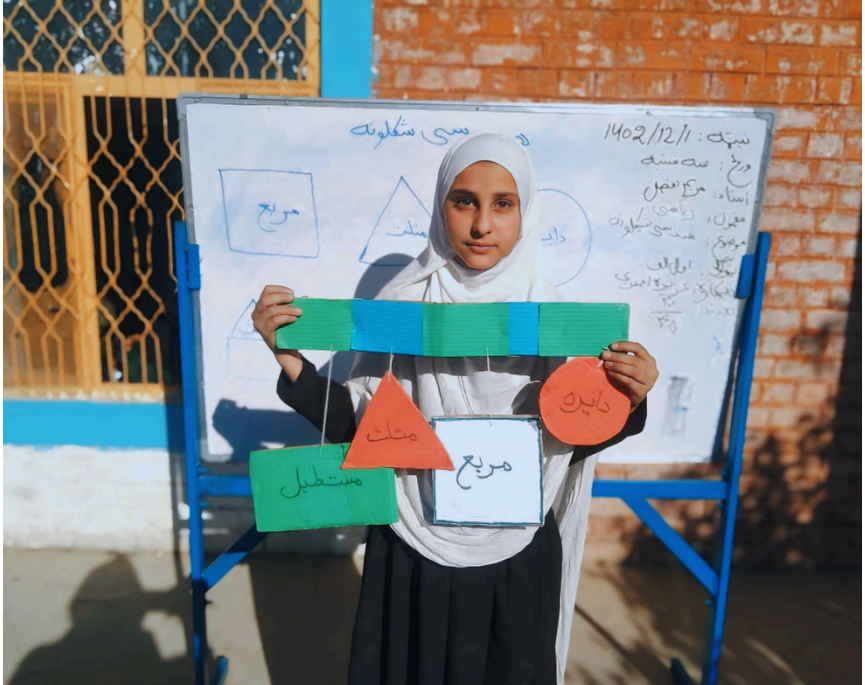
- Monthly and annual taxes paid consistently

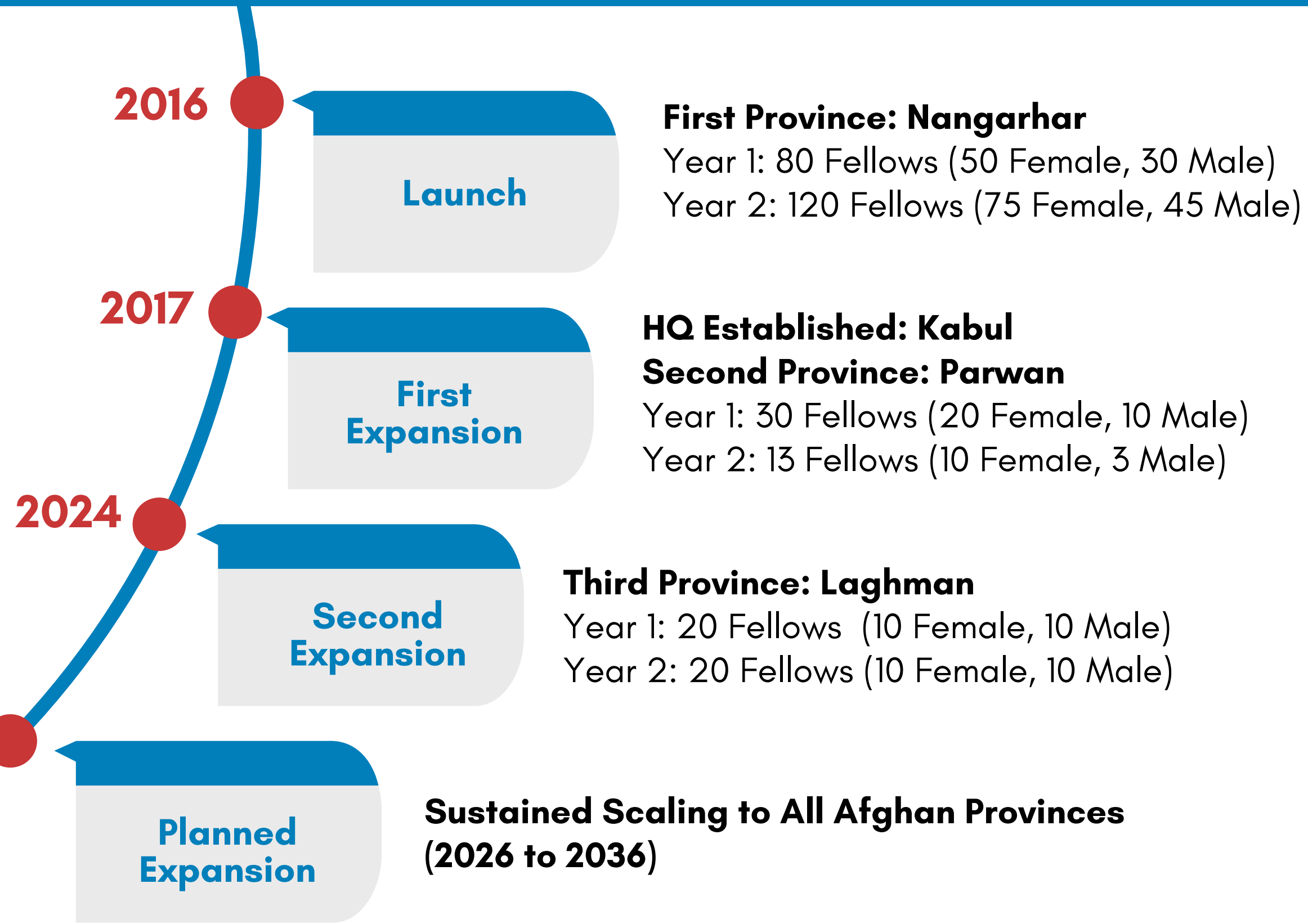

Champion for Afghan Women

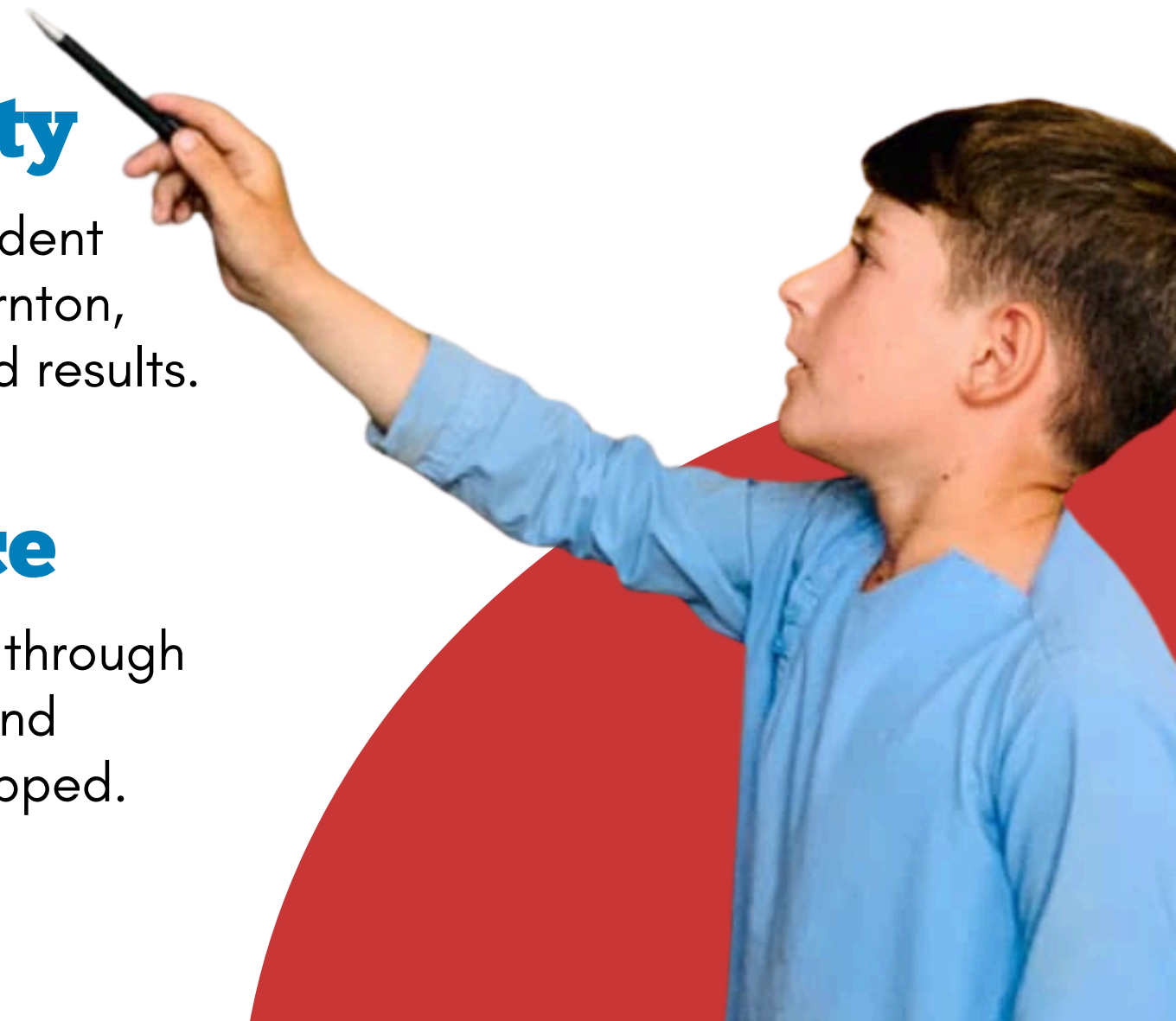
72% of students impacted are girls. 50% of our staff is female. We create pathways for Afghan women when they need it most.

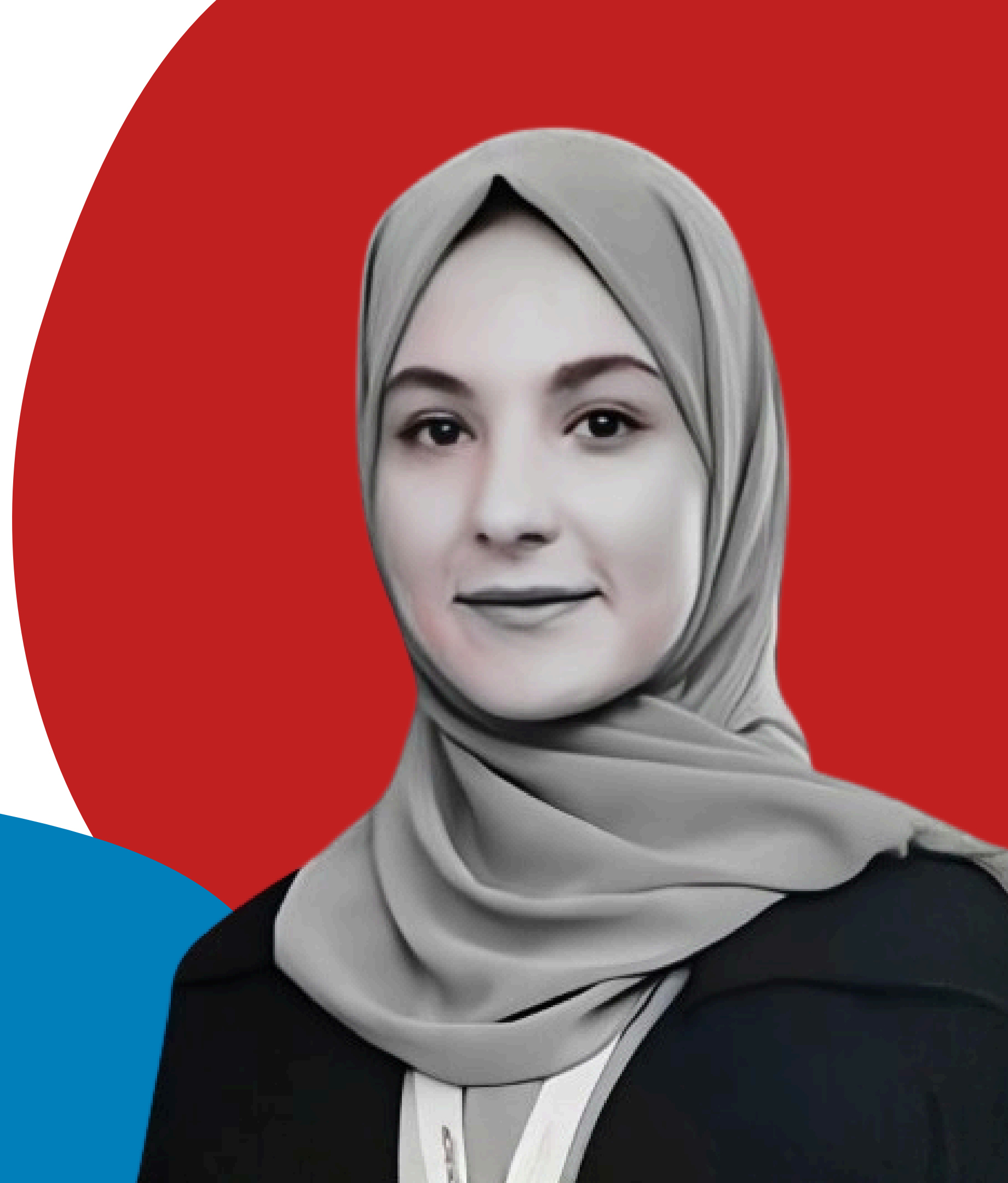

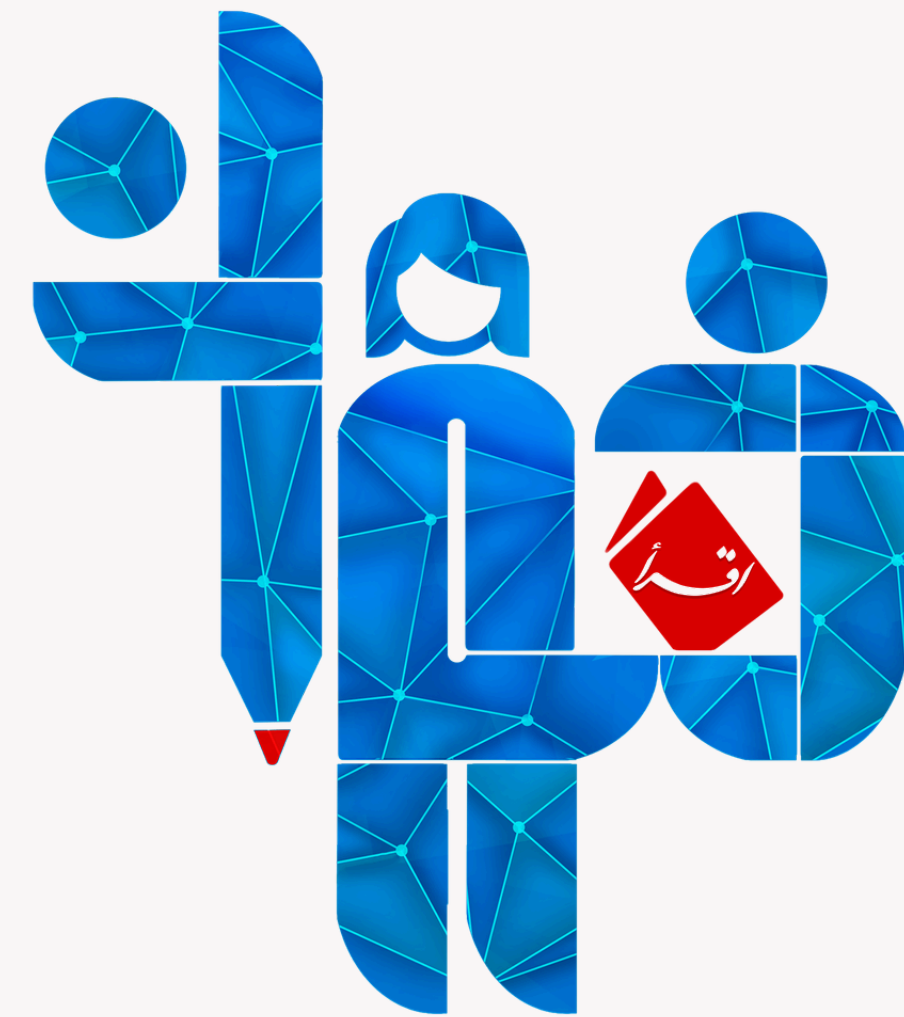
