Our history

We serve a socially and economically vulnerable population with limited opportunities to exercise their fundamental rights and at risk of dropping out of school, thereby losing access to better opportunities.



1985 - 1995

- Casa PAS begins its activities.
- The 1985 earthquake shapes its approach to working with the community.
- The Instituto Cultural Pedro Domecq, A.C. donates the Yácatas house.

1996 - 2006

- Casa PAS begins its institutional professionalization process with the support of Fundación Merced, A.C.
- It obtains authorized donor status from the SAT.
- It receives the CEMEFI Institutional Transparency and Accountability Certification.
- A reengineering process is launched with the support of Fundación EDUCA, A.C., establishing the Fundraising Department.

2007 - 2016

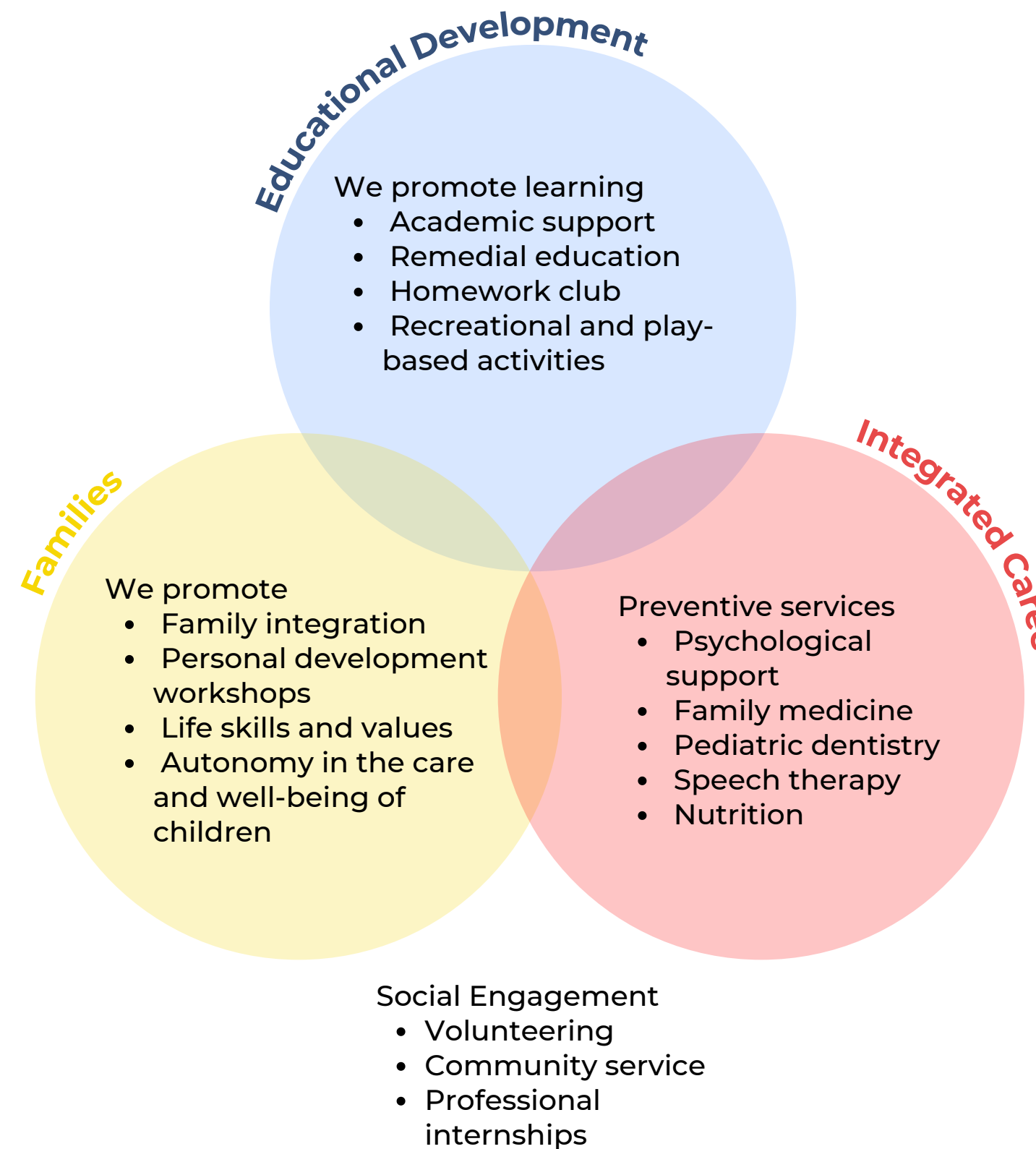
- The first Balanced Scorecard and five-year strategic plan are developed.
- The first campaign to increase individual donors is launched.
- Operational manuals and job descriptions are implemented.
- The first project proposals are submitted to Indesol and Fomento Social Banamex.

2017 - Present

- A Board of Trustees is established to support fundraising efforts.
- The service model is defined through three programs: Educational Development, Comprehensive Care, and Families.
- Work with the governing body is strengthened.
- A professional team is consolidated.
- A monitoring and evaluation project is launched.
- A social media communication strategy is initiated.

Our model requires a systemic approach involving families, schools, and Casa PAS, aiming to generate an impact on the developmental areas of each child and their families, while ensuring full respect for human rights at all times.

Human Rights Based Approach

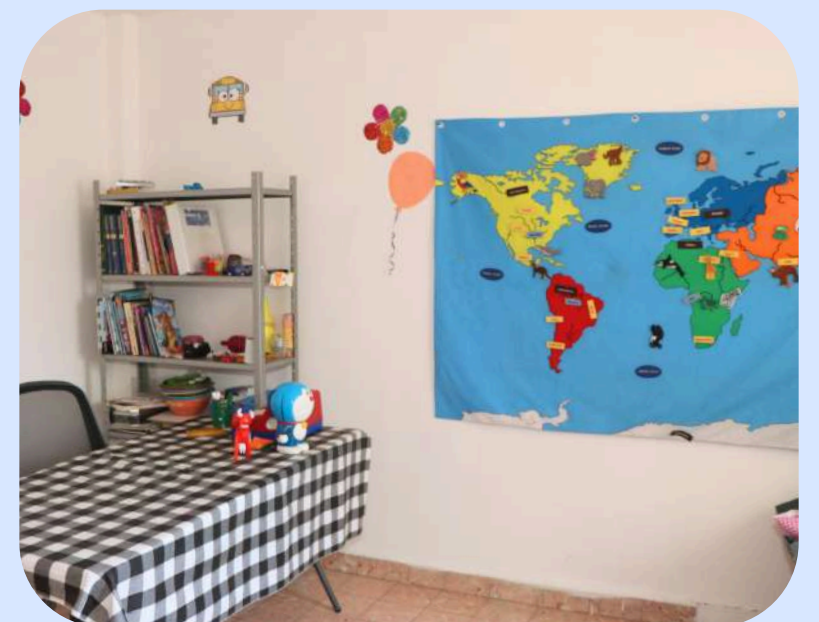
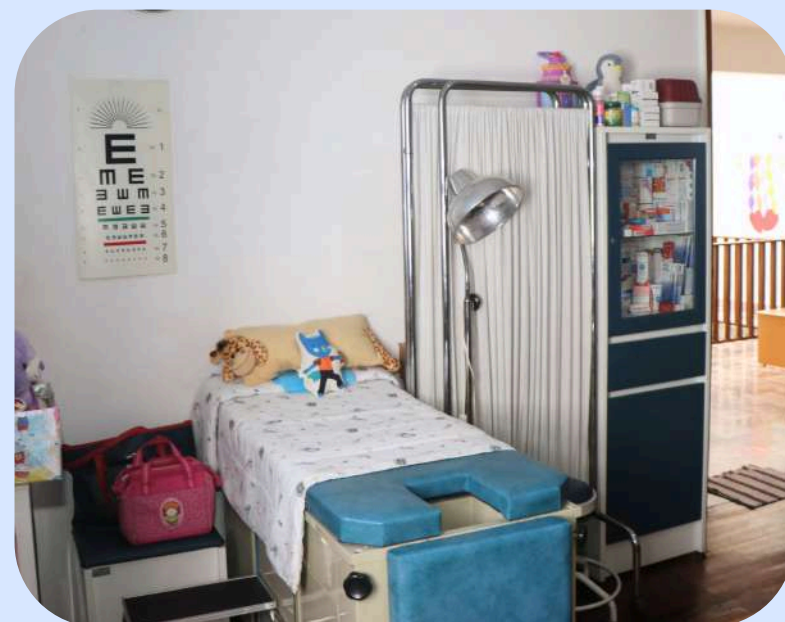
