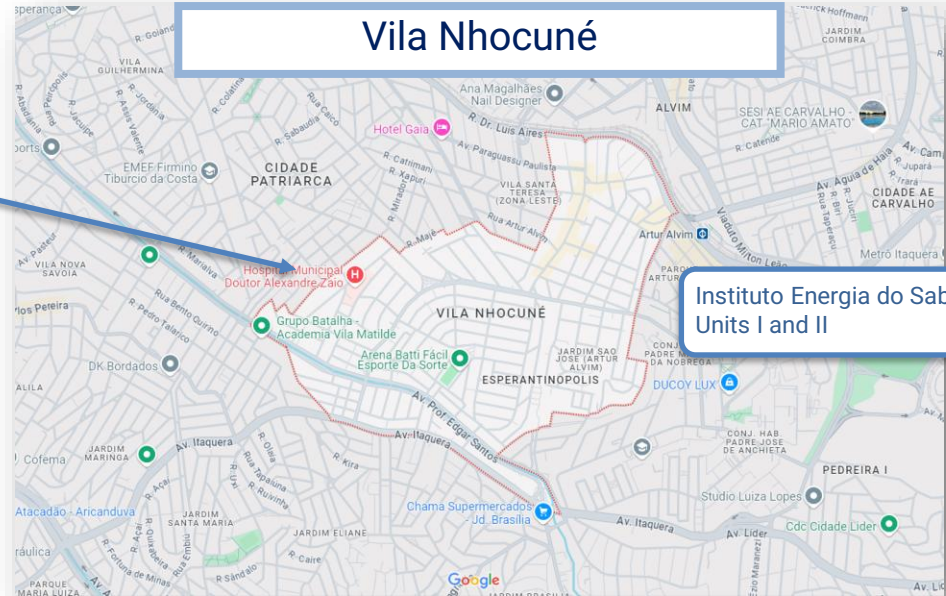




Who we are and where we are

Instituto Energia do Saber is a non-profit organization that offers high-quality education from elementary to high school for around 250 low-income children and Youth. We are located in east area of the city of São Paulo in Brazil.



What problem do we want to address?

- In PISA 2022, Brazil ranked 53rd out of 65 countries assessed, close to Jamaica, Argentina, and Colombia (OECD);
- In public high schools, only 4.5% of 3rd-year students reach adequate learning in Portuguese and Mathematics (IDEB 2023);
- 8.7 million young people aged 14 to 29 did not complete high school in 2024 (IBGE/PNAD). Even among those who completed high school, 17% remain functionally illiterate (Basic Education Yearbook 2025);
- According to INEP, on the national average, only 33% of 2023 high school graduates enrolled in higher education in 2024

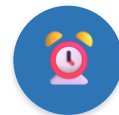


What do we offer?



Regular School

We offer high-quality education for our students across Elementary I, Elementary II, and High School levels. Our regular program focuses on delivering a robust, holistic academic foundation.



After-School Classes

We provide after-school classes for our Elementary I students, including academic support, arts, music, and sports activities.



Learning Materials

We use educational materials from Somos Educação, one of Brazil's leading education companies.



Teacher Training

Ongoing development via monthly lectures on topics chosen by educators.



Saber para o Futuro Program

The program equips high school students for the job market. We focus on three pillars: self-awareness, introducing the world of work and higher education opportunities, and co-creating a career with them.



Daily Meals

We provide balanced meals for all our Elementary I children, including breakfast, lunch, and an afternoon snack each day.



Outings & Volunteers

We organize visits to museums, universities and companies, offering students cultural enrichment, a glimpse into higher education and career insights.



Two Units & Labs

A technology lab (30 laptops) and a science lab across two units.

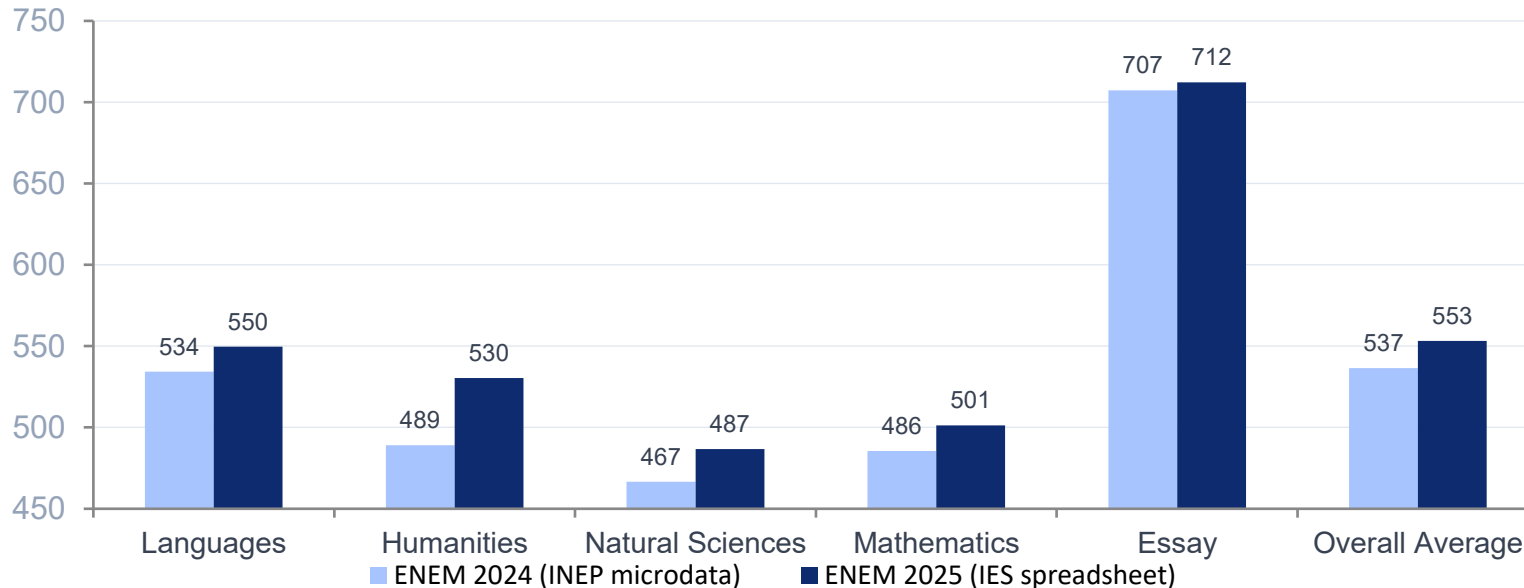
The SROI index shows how many reais are generated for society in benefits for every R\$1 real invested in the project
