Our core target is underserved communities in Venezuela, as of today, our number one priority is tending to the affected communities in La Guaira after the June 24th earthquake.

To contribute to the overall well-being of communities by bringing primary healthcare to anyone affected, displaced or with any kind of injury after the earthquake.

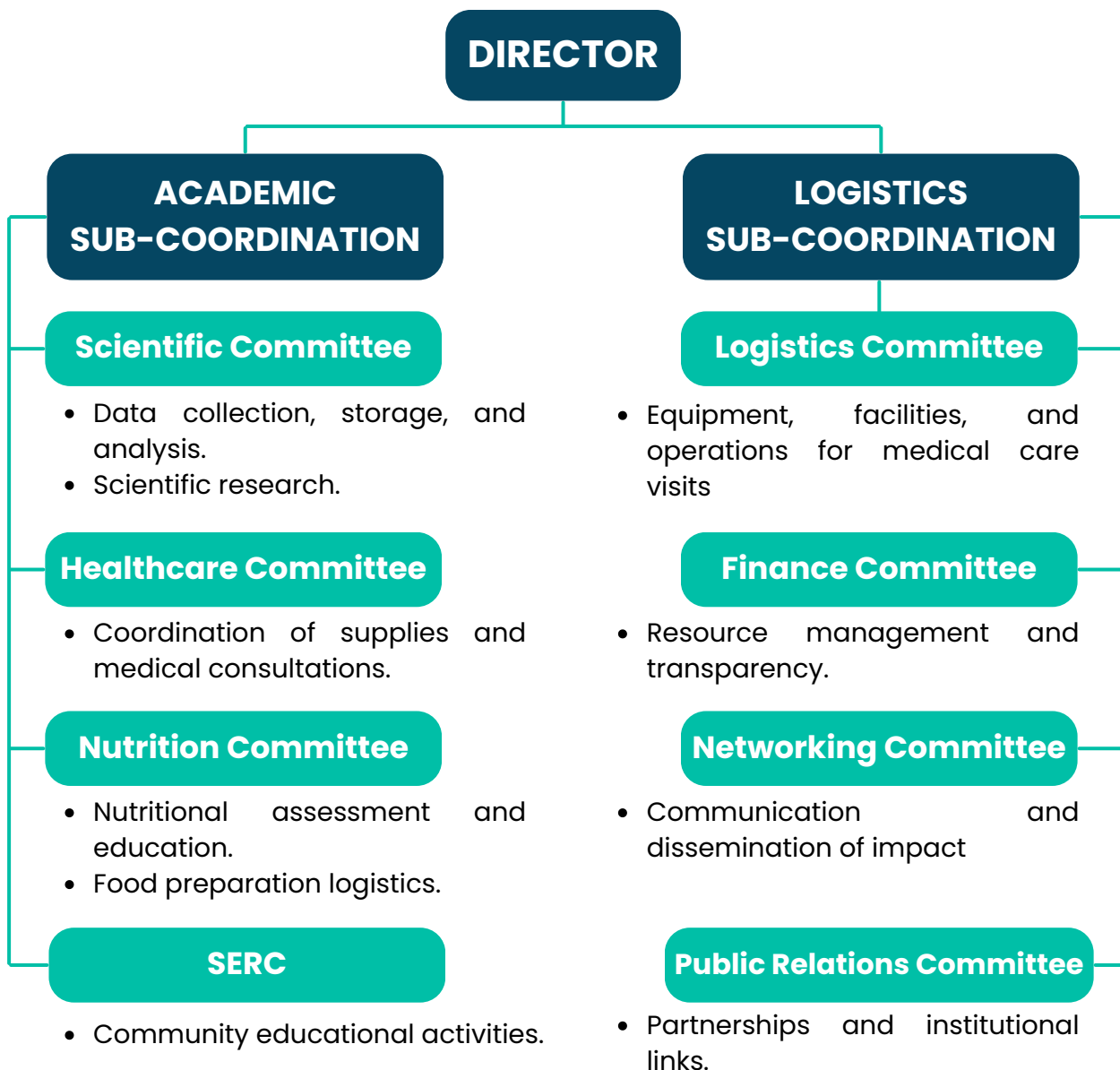
Supply them with clothing, personal hygiene products and potable water.

OUR WORK IN LA GUAIRA

We have established a donation center at our university Universidad Central de Venezuela, where the resources collected are processed and stored by volunteers, and then shipped to La Guaira and hospitals in Caracas who are receiving survivors on a need-based system.

WHAT RESOURCES ARE PROCESSED?

We manage monetary resources as well as physical ones, as: medical supplies, medications, clothing, personal hygiene products and food (for animals and humans)

All monetary donations are destined toward the purchase of more of the physical resources mentioned above, for which we provide daily reports of each purchase with their receipts (in Venezuelan Bolivars, which we exchange from USD or EUR donated to our international accounts).

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INCOME AND EXPENSE TRACKING

Income Traceability:

- Detailed classification of operational, logistical, and programmatic expenses to optimize budget utilization and prevent deviations.

Reconciliation and Verification:

- Monthly cross-referencing of internal records with bank statements to ensure 100% transparency in cash flow.
- Real-time data updates to provide accurate financial snapshots for board and donor reviews.

Resource Optimization:

- Analysis of historical data within our tracking system to improve financial planning and scalability for future community projects.
