Venezuela Earthquakes



We are closely monitoring the humanitarian crisis unfolding in Venezuela following the two devastating earthquakes that struck on 24th June. More than 4,500 people have died, over 16,700 have been injured, and approximately 17,900 have been displaced or left homeless ([OCHA](#)).

The risk of secondary public health emergencies is growing as access to safe water, sanitation and essential healthcare remains severely disrupted. Overcrowded shelters and ongoing rainfall are further increasing the risk of infectious disease outbreaks.

Our in-country partners are already reporting rising cases of diarrheal disease, skin infections, urinary tract infections, dehydration and respiratory illnesses. At the same time, mental health needs remain significant as families cope with displacement, loss and ongoing uncertainty.

Today, IHP is one of Europe's leading organisations specialising in medical donations. With great expertise we navigate the complex logistics of international shipping, from securing import permits and temperature-controlled packaging to managing multimodal transport. We oversee the entire process from start to finish, ensuring that each delivery is safe, efficient, and impactful.

Our priority in any emergency is to ensure that the right medical and health supplies reach the people who need them most - quickly, responsibly, and in close coordination with trusted partners.

IHP are preparing a shipment which will enable our partner, **Project HOPE**, to deliver an emergency health response in earthquake-affected areas of Venezuela, where critical shortages are disrupting access to essential primary healthcare services. The shipment will provide immediate, life-saving care for **28,800 patients**, while strengthening local emergency response capacity. It will include 36 **Essential Health Packs (EHPs)**, portable pharmacies containing a wide range of primary healthcare medicines to meet urgent health needs in the affected areas.
