Most of our church home are in need of Kitchens. They either prepare food in the open place or in a half finished sheller. That means sunshine, wind, rain are all a threat for children not having their food on time. To construct a kitchen with a small ealing area, it costs 2500 dollars.

WOMEN OF WORTH EMPOWERMENT PROGRAM

Every other day, there's a Ugandan women whose heart is being broken by a man whom she once gave her life and accepted to mother his children. Even while raising a girl child in Uganda, She is raised as a second class citizen who is there to please a man. The role of a woman is to give birth to children for a man, go in the garden growing food for them and stay in the Kitchen cooking for her children and her husband. As a results, these women have no income of their own. They just depend on their husbands for everything. This makes the husbands take them as burdens and thus subject them to all form of abuse. Many are beaten aggressively and others chased out of their houses, and unfortunately society will always blame the woman if the marriage fails for whatsoever reason. It's for this reason that we startes the woman of worth Empowerment program, aiming at teaching these women some income generating projects so that they become also self reliant lest they get abused by their husbands. More than 300 women have been taught skills in Baking, Tailoring, Hand craft skills. Most of them are doing small businesses which are sustaining.

OUR MAJOR ACTIVITIES

★ Woman Baking Program

Sofar, we have more than 15 Baking ovens in 15 different churches where women meet every Thursday to learn how to bake cakes and confectionaries.

Many have started small businesses and are supporting their children and even husbands.

We however still believe God to construct other ovens in our other churches so that we can reach as many women as possible.

Besides, some women do not have even the small capital they need to begin a small business.

We believe God enable them to begin the mony generation businesses..

★ Liquid Soap Making

This program was originally set up for the Boy child in our ministry. They make liquid soap and sell it a round in the neighbouring communities. They have even started a savings scheme from the income from this project. However, we now have girls who have shown interest in this project and are active participators too.



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INTRODUCTION

Uganda is very beautiful naturally endowed country located in the eastern part of Africa.

It is commonly known as the pearl of Africa, A name that was given to it by the Britsh Prime minister Sir. Church hill Winston during his tour in Africa. However, with the outbreak of the AIDS pandemic and the political insurgency, the pain and misery amongst its people has hidden it's natural splendour.

Nearly one in five children of uganda is an orphan. HIV is the main cause of this, with malaria being a close second. Children are left helpless, poor, hungry and vulnerable. And when not given help, they also end up contracting the same diseases that snatched away their parents.

CHILD CARE MINISTRY

This year many of our Children have been able to be Baptised, receive the Holy Communion for the first, and confirmation in the Catholic church which has been a big milestone in their lives.

It is because of this apealling state that Brother Kajubi Jimmy a compassionate community leader with other two Brothers and friends who also were brought up in the same home of Nuns of Immaculate conception of the most holy virgin mary an environment that shaped their values of resilience, empathy, and service inspired by the care and christian values they received as a children committed them selves to give back to vulnerable children tacing similar challenges. We not only provide Shelter and essential care, but also instils strong christian values among children and staff throught their work we empasizes faith, Love, discipline and hope guiding young people to grow in to responsible spiritually grounded members of the society Driven by this personal story and deep faith, we continue to empower children with the belief that God has a purpose for every life regardless of background or circumstances.

ABOUT THE FOUNDER AND SOME PRACTICAL PROJECTS

● Tailoring Program

This is especially targeting our girl child. In order to keep them engaged during the challenging adolescent stage while at the same time give them a life time skill, we started a tailoring program at two of our centres. So far, we have around 15 sewing machines, for the more than 95 girls in this program. This is quite challenging. We believe God to give us more sewing machines for this program. A sewing machine costs 120 dollars.

● Water / Bore Hole Supply

In many communities of Uganda, one has to walk a distance of around 4 miles to get water. The unfortunate thing is that this water is in the open and is shared with animals. It can be a source of death, Instead of life. It's like trekking this four miles to just tetch Dysentery, Cholera or Bilharzias. But what can we do? You can't live without water any way. We are looking for ways to see how we can construct like 10 bore holes in our communities where each serves a population of a bout 5000 famillies A bore hole costs 10,000 dollars to construct.

SCHOOL FEES:

To keep a child in school, we need 50 dollars per month, which is 240 dollars a year.

CLOTHES

50 Dollars can keep one child well provided with clothes for a year.

BAKING OVER

For one commercial baking oven for a church community, it takes 500 dollars.

MEALS

To feed one child three mean a day, we need 3 dollars, That means 90 dollars for a month.
