1. Who We Are

Fundación Patitas y Sonrisas JDUC is a non-profit organization dedicated to animal protection, support for vulnerable communities, and the management of social and environmental development projects. Led by Jonatan David Urueña Cifuentes, our team has mobilized in response to the recent earthquake emergency in Colombia to provide direct, humane, and transparent assistance to affected families and animals.

2. Project Description and Justification

The recent earthquake has left hundreds of families homeless and thousands of animals displaced, exposed to hunger, harsh weather, and a lack of medical care. No one can be left behind. This project aims to comprehensively and sustainably address both urgent human needs and the well-being of the affected animals.

3. 3-Phase Action Plan (Long-Term Sustainability)

Our approach goes beyond a one-time aid distribution. The project is executed in three strategic stages:

- **Phase 1: Immediate Relief (Emergency)**
 - Collection, packaging, and mass transportation of supplies from Bogotá to the affected areas.

- Delivery of non-perishable food kits, clean water, hygiene supplies, and basic necessities for families.
 - Distribution of pet food (cuido), blankets, and first-aid supplies for rescued dogs and cats.
- **Phase 2: Recovery and Health**
 - Basic veterinary care campaigns, wound treatments, vaccinations, and medication supplies for affected animals.
 - Ongoing nutritional monitoring and support for the most vulnerable families during the months following the disaster.
- **Phase 3: Community Sustainability**
 - Creation of local support networks to ensure that families and temporary shelters have stable resources to rebuild their futures.
