

About Custom Orthoses

Custom lower limb orthoses, designed and fabricated in the United States and Canada, have been donated to our company by the children who outgrew them. They are re-fabricated and modified in our Negril facility to fit a Jamaican child in need. The orthoses outgrown by the children during the course of treatment are recycled to meet new patient needs.

The initial cost of each orthoses can range from US\$1600 to US\$8000. In addition to production costs, travel to the US or Canada, and other factors, can make it too costly to obtain needed treatment in Jamaica. A lack of treatment can mean a lifetime of hardship.



Our treatment goals are to:

- Enhance the function and mobility of children with lower limb disabilities.
- Reduce pain.
- Foster independence.

Thanks to the generous support from RIU Resorts, all services of the clinic are available to all in need, regardless of their ability to pay.

With treatment, children with lower limb disabilities will need less assistance from full-time caregivers, and can become productive members of society.

Our patients come from many backgrounds with one common need. We fill that need with the dedicated efforts of sponsors and volunteers by creating an orthotic centre that will be local and sustainable.



Working with doctors and physiotherapists from across the island, our patients are assured that their care is integrated and comprehensive. Physical therapy and orthotic treatment is the best treatment option when combined with the involvement and training of the daily care giver.
