AUGUST 10, 2026

A magnitude 7.4 earthquake, with its epicenter in San José del Palmar, Chocó, shook the west of the country. In less than a minute it changed the life of hundreds of thousands of communities.

This earthquake made visible the inequities and structural problems of many territories in the country. It is also a reminder that organized communities are already here, walking a path that puts life at the center, that recognizes the interdependence (the collaboration) between human beings and nature, and that sows hope in the territories.

Local organizations have been responding to the emergency from moment zero

Direct care

Mapping the territory, learning what is needed and attending to the most urgent situations, the ones that call for a fast response.

Mobilization

Bringing together people and resources to respond to the crisis in their territories, according to each context.

Coordination and connection

Working as facilitators among organizations, local leaders and sectors, based on their relationships and the trust they have built.

These are the attributes of community philanthropy.

Trust-based philanthropy

- 1** **We identify** local organizations through the Territorial Foundations and relationships that already existed.
- 2** **We listen:** each organization prioritizes its own needs and opportunities and defines how to respond in its context.
- 3** **We mobilize** resources from national and international philanthropy and from individual donors.
- 4** **We transfer** the funds directly to the priorities the territory defined.
- 5** **We accompany** with follow-up and transparent accountability for our allies.

The goal is concrete.

\$500 million COP

Phase 1: sustain the response of the nine organizations during the crisis stage.

Phase 2: a philanthropic vehicle for preventing and responding to future emergencies.
