Come volunteer as a camp counselor for the Change My Stars English Immersion Camp in Puerto Plata, Dominican Republic with Project Esperanza.

Dates: 1-4 weeks (minimum of 2 weeks recommended) between June 25 and Aug. 6, 2011

Costs: (Covers stay, meals, program transportation, and a program fee. Airfare, transportation to and from airport, and recreational transportation not included.)

1 week: \$200 2 weeks: \$285 3 weeks: \$445 4 weeks: \$590

What will volunteers do? Execute an English immersion summer camp for four hours each weekday morning in the center of town. Campers will be mainly Dominican children ages 5 to 14. Execute varying activities for about two hours in the afternoons in a majorly Haitian populated community. On the weekends volunteers will visit other Project Esperanza sites and have time for the beach, 27 waterfalls, and other recreational activities.

Where will voluteers stay? In the same building that the camp will be held in the center of town, just two blocks from the boardwalk and beach. Meals will be cooked for volunteers either at the building or within a short walking distance.

What is Project Esperanza? A non-profit organization based in Blacksburg, VA and Puerto Plata, DR. Programs mainly serve the Haitian immigrant community in Puerto Plata in the areas of education, social work, and community development.
