### PROJECTS&ACHIEVEMENTS

During May, a pediatric visit was completed in Noccan Kani, Santa Fe. 17 children received pediatric medical attention. Most of them were treated for respiratory conditions. Also, regular medical check-ups and ophthalmology services were offered. The children were treated for lice and also got haircuts.








A feeding center in González Catán, province of Buenos Aires, was added to our assistance plan. This month 150 children received pediatric services.



We sent High School CEP No 48 located in Las Garcitas, Province of El Chaco different donations including books, school supplies, clothing, shoes, computers, a stereo equipment, a TV set and furniture. This school has 415 students.

We also continue to provide several feeding centers in the provinces of Tucumán, Buenos Aires and Santa Fe with powdered milk.




