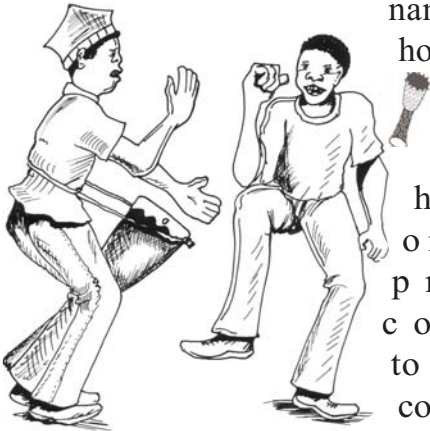

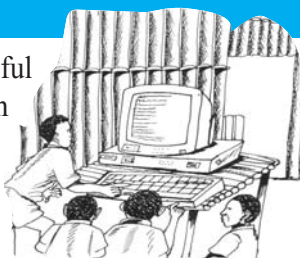


Organisational Philosophy an open field
