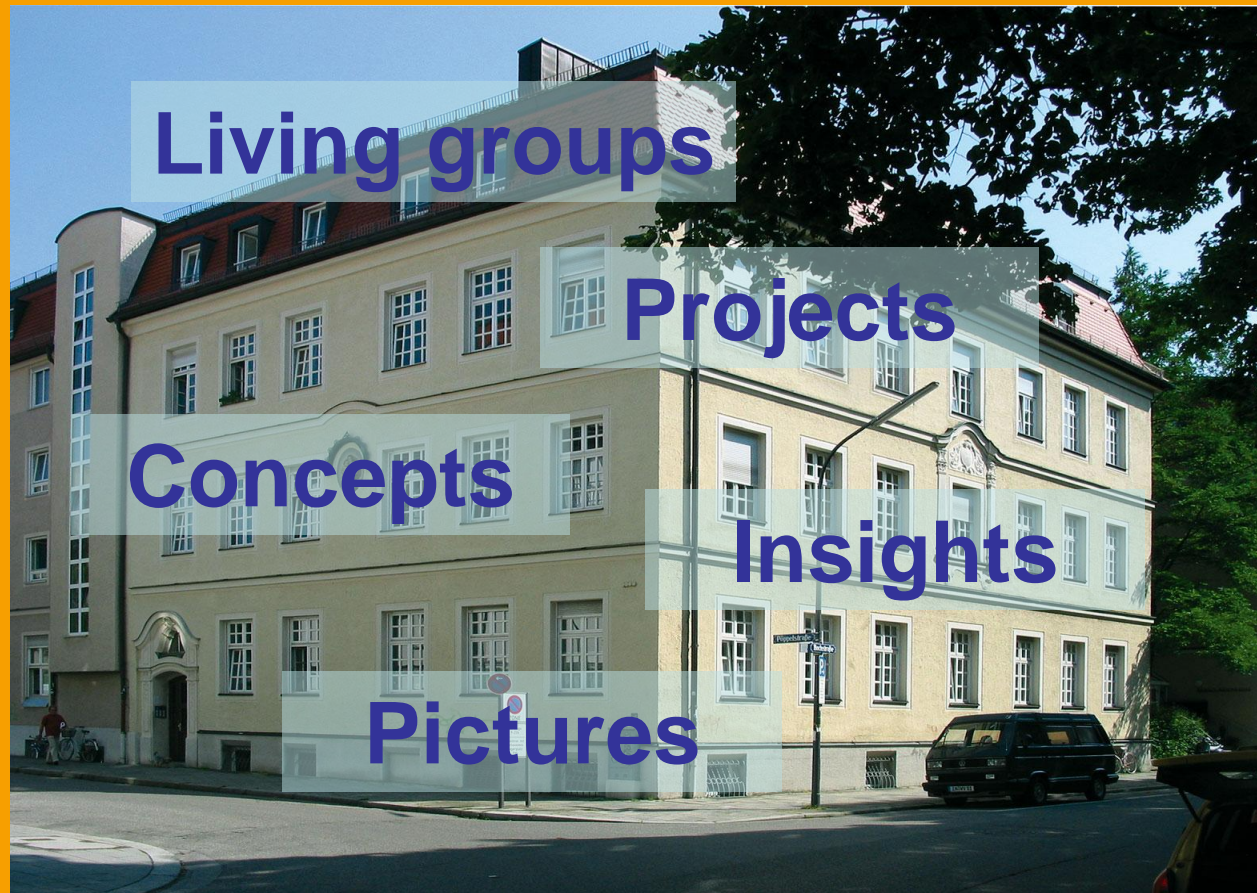


Adelgundenheim introduces itself

Target of the care

Strengthening the ability to create relationships, encourage the autonomy and the maturity of the children and adolescents with the target of reintegration into the family or companionship towards an independent form of life.



Target group

We care for 90 children and adolescents that cannot remain in their families because of various personal circumstances such as incidents of violence, parents' drug abuse, parental inabilities.

Age: from 6 years up to the end of schooling or professional education.

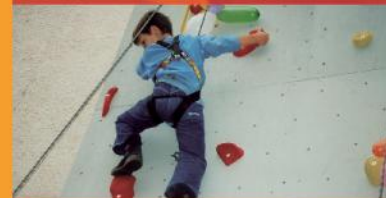
In the day care center 36 children at the age of 0-3 years are under care.

Currently 94 Employees work in the Adelgundenheim:

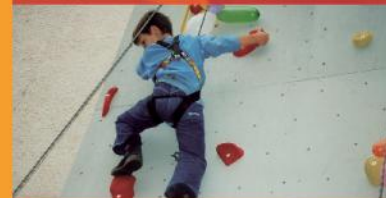
- Head of the institution

Homely, comfortably designed group tenements with single or double rooms, kitchen and living room.

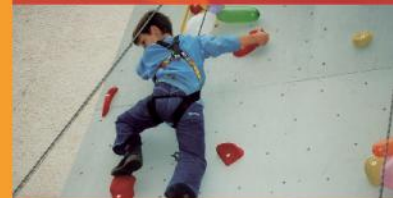

Capacity: 6

Students from 5th to 9th grade

Addressing students

- who refuse to take part in school lessons or who refuse to visit school at all.
- who are excluded from school for disturbance or violent behaviour.
- who are placed in a youth welfare service home and need to be reintegrated into public educational system.

Ambulant section: Day structuring assistance



Capacity: 6

Care for children and adolescents during the afternoon.

Including:

- Mutual lunch
- Educational care, time for school homework, additional school trainings
- Media-free, meaningful recreation time
- Therapeutic assistance if required
- Parents' counseling including home visits
- Parents are welcome to attend all facilities offers like parents training courses.



Ambulant section: Occupational assistance

Target group:

8 – 10 adolescents

- with a high demand for support in personal and social concerns
- without school degree
- with high educational demands
- with a foreign background in need of extra linguistic training

Target:

- Support in entering the general professional training system by providing a combination of educational qualifying, professional occupation and pedagogic care.



Ambulant section: Occupational assistance



Possibilities of occupation within the facility

- Avoidance of a huge number of school drop-outs
