



**Lot 30 Cape Tribulation Road: Strategically located to increase an established wildlife corridor and connect protected rainforest, this property connects to the Daintree National Park / World Heritage Area through prior rescues. Lot 30 will extend the Rainforest Rescue Cape Kimberley Wildlife Corridor.**

This beautiful rainforest adjoins prior rescue, Lot 29, connecting it directly to the National Park. It is in close proximity to 10 properties protected by Rainforest Rescue that form the Cape Kimberley Wildlife Corridor and the Milky Pine Wildlife Refuge; its protection further enhances these areas.

Rare and endangered species such as Southern Cassowaries and Bennett's Tree-Kangaroos have been seen in this vicinity, and ancient primitive flowering plants abound. Buying this property will enable us to extend a priceless and important wildlife and biodiversity nature corridor, significantly building upon existing Rainforest Rescue protected areas. This buy back is of vital importance and prevents rainforest destructive development.

“One thing that resonated with both of us while surveying this property on April 11 was that, if settled, the owners would invariably make an access and house clearing to take advantage of views at the top of the ridgeline. These views look to the south, taking in the Daintree River and coastline looking back towards Port Douglas. Considerable earthworks and clearing would be necessary and would make a dramatic impact on the natural values of the land.

Acquiring this property augments the integrity of the wildlife corridor we have already established through lots 29, 32 & 33.
