THE PROBLEM

- In Nyadire, 90% of children are infected with schistosomiasis.
- Also known as bilharzia, it is a parasitic worm infection.
- It is the leading cause of chronic disease among children.
- Infection drastically increases transmission rates of HIV.

OUR SOLUTION

- We will implement Zimbabwe's first schistosomiasis control program. We hope to target 120,000 people in rural, northeastern Nyadire, Zimbabwe.
- Treatment will be conducted at primary schools in the area.
- Our strategy is Mass Drug Administration: giving one to three tablets of
